Whereas, the current political environment has included derogatory rhetoric targeting various groups including but not limited to immigrants; people of color; Muslims and other religious minorities; LGBTQ individuals; women; and individuals with disabilities; and

Whereas, many Santa Ana College students have expressed, both in public and in private, confusion, anxiety and fear regarding their physical safety and well-being, along with concerns about their individual rights, all of which negatively impacts their academic achievement, and

Whereas, Santa Ana College's mission statement embraces our "diverse community" and our district has a clearly outlined non-discrimination policy stating that we_shall provide access to district services, classes, and programs without regard to "national origin, religion, age, gender, gender identity, gender expression, race or ethnicity, color, medical condition, genetic information, ancestry, sexual orientation, marital status, physical or mental disabilities, pregnancy or military and veteran status..." Resolved, the Academic Senate encourages all faculty to use the learning environment to show compassion and support for students who may be experiencing anxiety, uncertainty and fear in the current political environment.
