WHEREAS, students are challenged to complete degrees and certificates when courses are impacted and are able to take said classes at other accredited community colleges and transfer those units to Santa Ana College, and

WHEREAS, enrolling in classes at other community colleges is challenging due to the lack of a single streamlined application process, and

WHEREAS, the Online Education Initiative Exchange has created a single, streamlined application process whereby students are able to enroll once and Santa Ana College joining the exchange would allow our students to register for CI-D aligned courses with their current registration priority, increasing the likelihood that they are able to complete their degrees and certificates, and

RESOLVED, Santa Ana College will apply to become part of the OEI Exchange when the Exchange begins accepting additional colleges in 2018.
