- **Online Degree Pathway**
 - Nine graduates in Spring 2016!
 - All Business Admin, AS-T have transferred to CSUF
 - One is a Liberal Arts graduate that is now planning to continue coursework for transfer.
- **DE Growth Plans**
 - Toward the effort of providing necessary online courses for SAC students and college growth efforts, doubling of the Online Teaching Certification (OTC) will take place for the semesters of FA16, SP17, SU17, FA17, SP18.
 - Faculty stipend incentives available for OTC and online course development.
 - %DE and Total FTES comparison to comparable FTES colleges show that we have growth opportunities.
- **OER Degree**
 - SAC was awarded the Achieving the Dream Open Educational Resources (OER) Degree Initiative grant
 - Nationwide initiative, SAC is one of 38 community colleges
 - Two OER degrees:

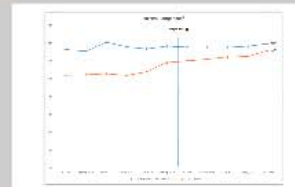

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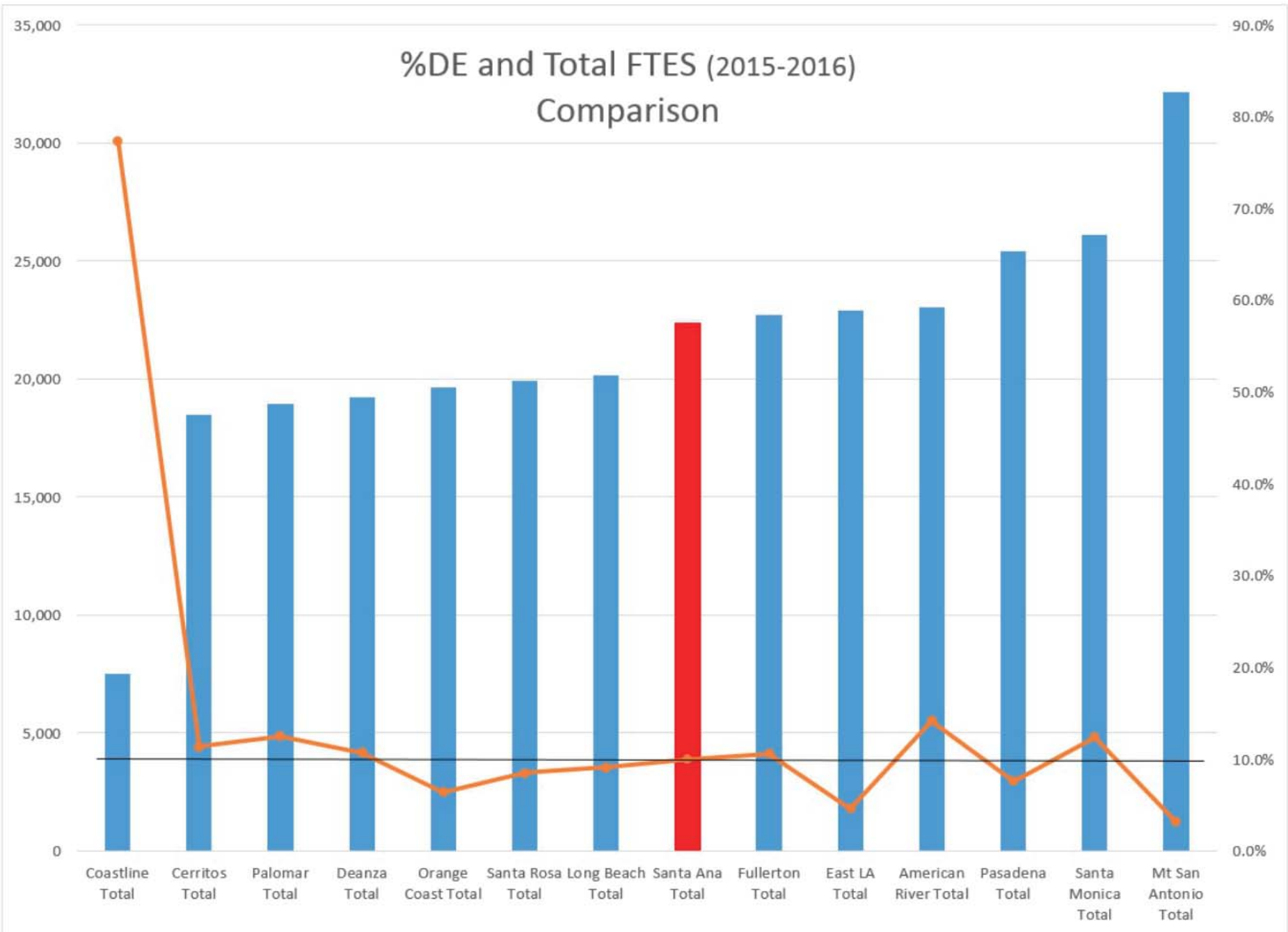
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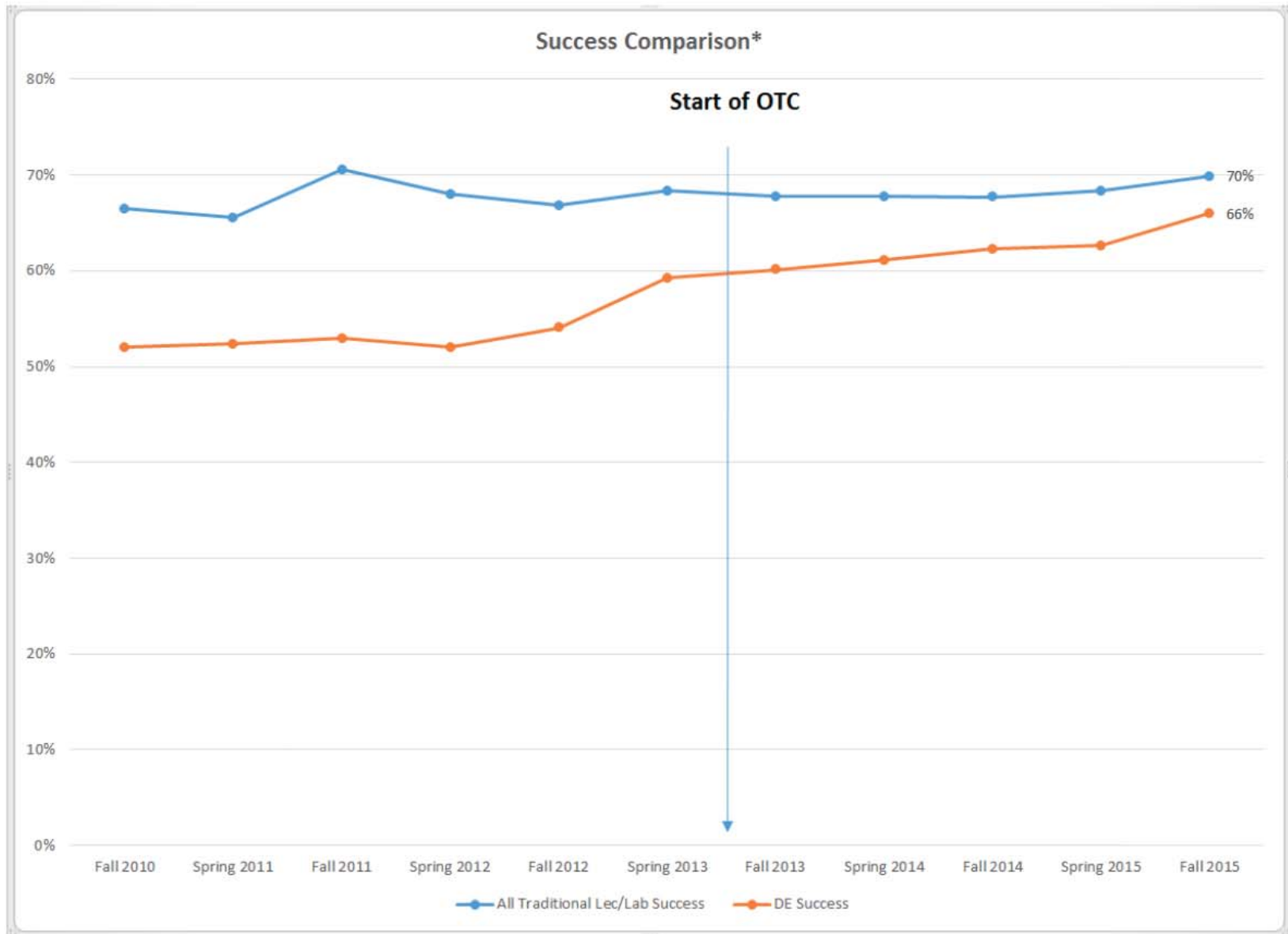
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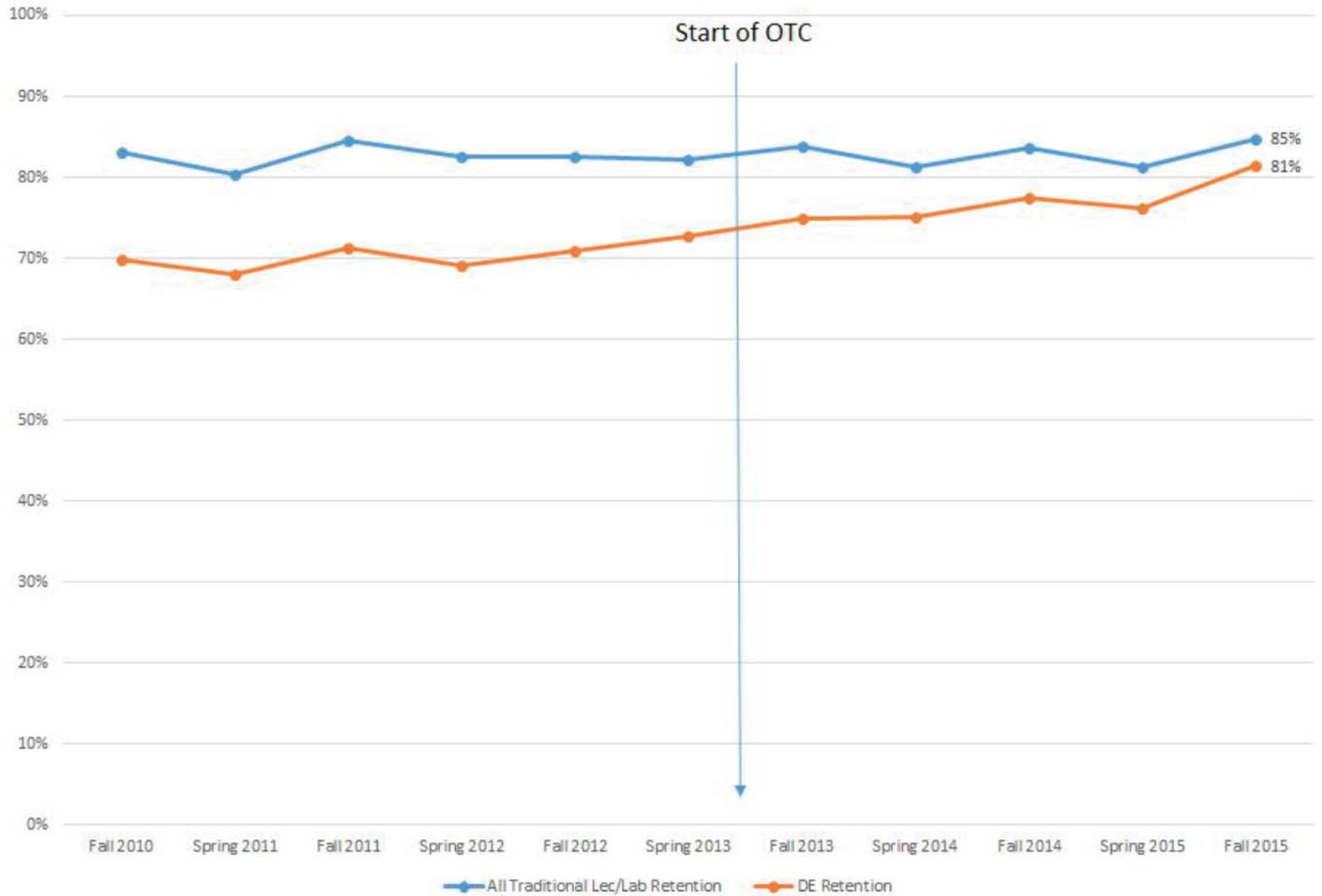
%DE and Total FTES (2015-2016) Comparison
