


CANVAS: Create TurnItIn Assignment

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There are two ways to add a TurnItIn assignment in Canvas: using the external tool, or the assignment integration. If TurnItIn PeerMark will be used, the external tool must be used.

ADD A TURNITIN ASSIGNMENT (Integrated)



In the Canvas assignment, select **Online** as the Submission Type. Click the **File Uploads** box to select it. Instructors may restrict the file types students can upload by selecting the Restrict Upload File Types check box.

Once the assignment submission type has been set to Online, and File Uploads has been selected, the Plagiarism Review field will appear.

Select **TurnItIn** from the pull down menu in the Plagiarism Review field.

Once TurnItIn has been enabled on the assignment, the **TurnItIn Submission Options** will appear.

Store Submissions should be set to **Standard Paper Repository**

Include the options for Student Repository, Website Content, and Periodicals, Journals and Publications.

For the Similarity Reports, instructors may want to exclude bibliographic materials and exclude quoted materials.

The settings can be **Saved as default setting**, which will automatically apply the saved settings to any future TurnItIn assignment in the course.


Show report to students recommended setting is **Immediately**. This will allow the students to see their originality report when the paper is submitted.

Students will submit the assignment through Canvas, and the instructor will grade the assignments through Canvas using the SpeedGrader, or in TurnItIn using QuickMark.


Important: Canvas Rubrics must be added to the Canvas assignment prior to enabling TurnItIn.

ADD A TURNITIN ASSIGNMENT (External Tool)


In the Canvas Assignment, select **External Tool** as the Submission Type. Click the **Find** button next to the Enter or Find External Tool URL field. In the Configure External Tool window, use the scroll bar on the side to scroll down and find and click to select **TurnItIn**. Click the **Select** button at the bottom.



Save and Publish the assignment in Canvas. Once the assignment has been saved, the TurnItIn assignment options will appear. Select the TurnItIn assignment options. Click Optional Settings to expand the section for additional assignment options. The recommended setting for Generate Similarity Reports for Student Submissions is **Immediately**. Click the checkbox next to Save These Settings for Future Use to save the selected settings. The saved settings will be automatically applied to all future TurnItIn assignments in the course. Click the **Submit** button to save the TurnItIn assignment settings.

The students will submit the assignment through the TurnItIn tool. Instructors will grade the assignments through Canvas using the SpeedGrader, or in TurnItIn using QuickMark.
