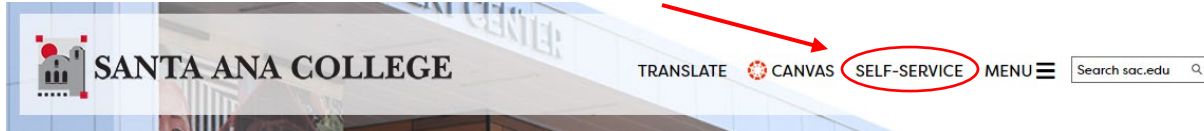


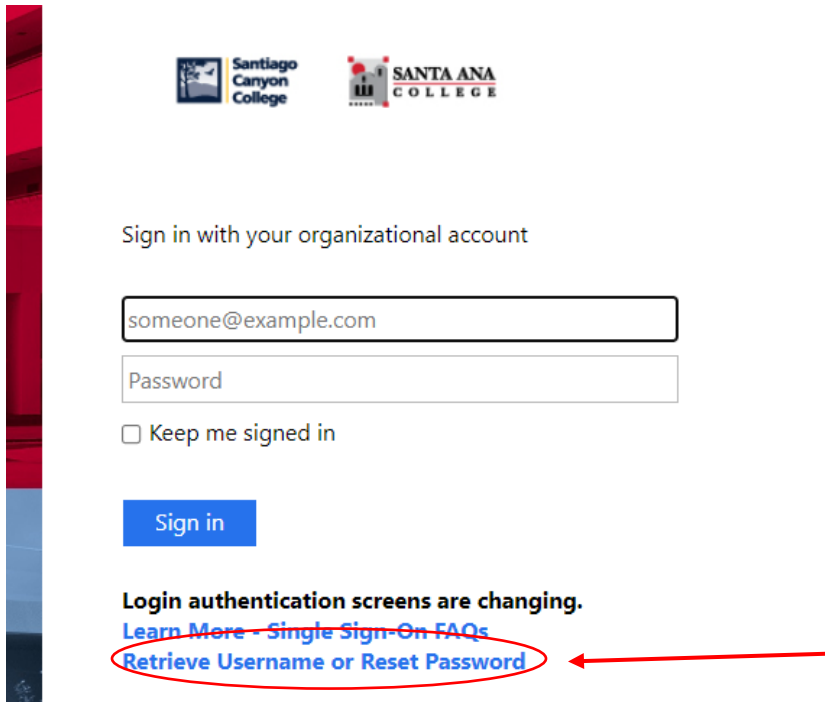

STEP 1: Go to www.sac.edu

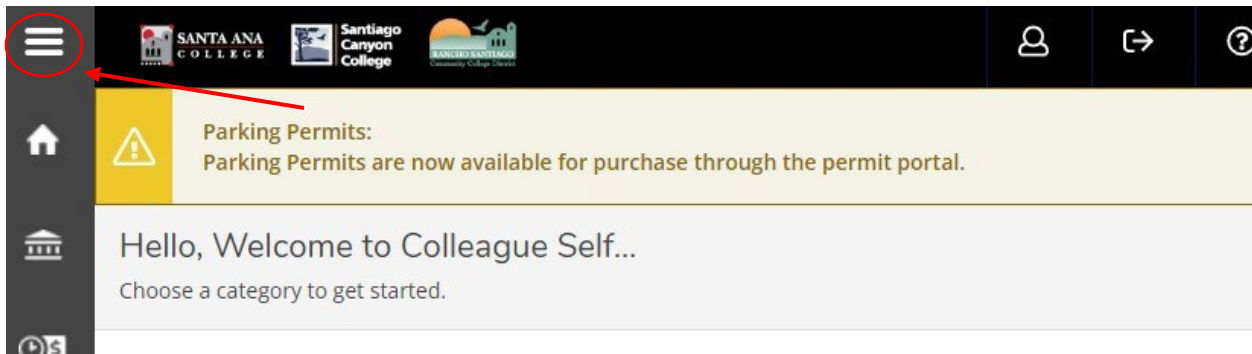
STEP 2: Click on Self-Service



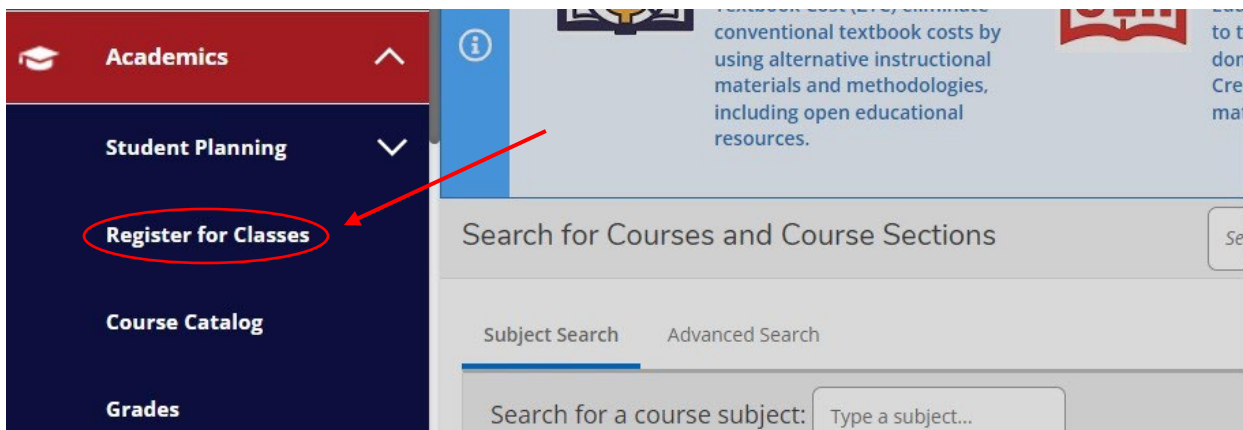
STEP 3: Log in (If you do not know your Username/Password, click on Retrieve Username or Reset Password)



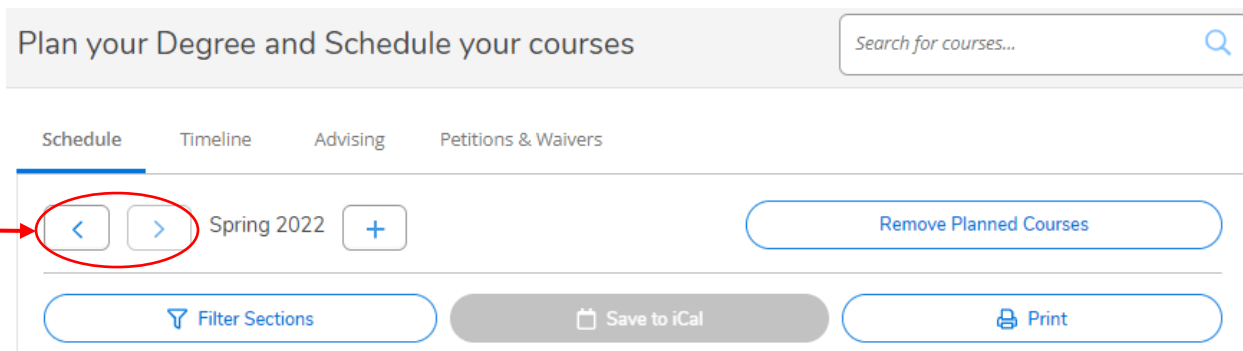
STEP 4: Click on 3 lines in the top left corner


