Paul Foster		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paul reported that trigger 2 will be pulled for 2012/2013. It will impact the funding to the district for this year, but will likely not impact local 2011-12 budgets. State looking at a \$12–13 billion deficit for 2012-13. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SAC will not be making any adjustments this year, but system-wide shortfalls will likely impact SAC next year. Orange County is trying to take the ERAF (Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund) portion of property tax revenue away from community colleges. Under Proposition 98 guidelines, those funds rightfully belong to community colleges. This SAC portion is between \$250,000 and \$400,000.

	<p>Update on Motion to College Council to distribute 40% of the \$14 mil of the "Excess District Reserve."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It was noted that this item was mentioned at the end of the last College Council meeting, but there was not time to fully discuss the topic; nor was a vote taken. <p>Discussion ensued. The committee wants to know that recommendations are going forward. The committee decided to reaffirm their motion of October 4, 2011.</p>	<p>ACTION</p> <p>The motion was made by George Wright to reaffirm the motion made on October 4, 2011 that a recommendation be made to College Council (December 14) that 40% of the \$14mil of the "Excess District Reserve" be operationalized for SAC, SCC and the District Office according to the percent distribution in the Adopted Budget.</p> <p>2nd – Tom Andrews</p> <p>The motion carried with 2 abstentions.</p>
	<p>Hiring Freeze Cost Savings</p> <p>Paul reported that this number is reflected in cuts made over the last three years. Administrative Services has not tracked the exact number of positions lost at SAC.</p>	
	<p>Budget Forum Review</p> <p>A discussion ensued regarding the recent Budget Forum at SAC.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Seems to be a disconnect between the district and SAC Ray will be meeting with the Chancellor in January to discuss the budget <p>The committee discussed the need for BAPR members to have a more proactive role in the development of the budget.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The budget has never been analyzed by BAPR members before being asked to approve. There needs to be an opportunity for BAPR members to be involved with the budget development earlier in the process. 	
	<p>Mechanism for potential future budget reductions.</p> <p>Dr. Rose presented a series of questions that could be considered by departments for future reductions.</p> <p>Discussion ensued.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Academic Affairs - what are we going to do that's different from what we've been doing to help our students move forward and reach their educational goals. Support Services – what can do to make sure that support services play a role in helping students be successful. Important to look at the college population and student success in a broader sense. Non-credit is growing in some community college – what are we doing to attract those students? Non-credit is not growing at CEC or OEC. Some of this is due to external demographic.
