

Staff has been instructed to assist students as needed. Signage will be placed there informing students to ask staff for help. Members were advised that the ADA Transition plan had been updated to reflect the new July 2010 legislation. College is required to have an ADA plan. New construction as well as renovations must adhere to guidelines. A survey has been developed by Monica Collins and is scheduled to be launched in a few weeks. 	Motion was moved by S. As a pilot plan beginning November 1 - The daytime cleaner will be removed from the classrooms in the I building and the boards will continued to be cleaned with the Expo cleaner at night. It was noted that the boards can be properly cleaned by the instructor with a dry cloth. John will discuss this with the Senate. Norm will discuss this with the deans.
