- II. Research Presentation K. Kawa (5 minutes) Degree Program Switches and Time to Degree Findings showed that about 9% students maintain the same program from beginning to end, 75% switch their program once, 15% change twice. As number of program switches increase, so does the number of years to graduate. Liberal Arts, CJ, and Business Administration were the Top 3 Programs at Entry, Liberal Arts, Business Administration, and CJ were the Top 3 Programs at Exit.
