FACILITY PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION AND DISTRICT SUPPORT SERVICES - PROJECT UPDATE by Joe Melendez

Projects Update:

- **Health Science building** is completed. Warranty issues have come up including significant flooding due to excessive rain. Additional issues that are being addressed are stairwells, window shades, card readers, signage.
- <u>Russell Hall</u> move out is complete. Demo to begin March. Updated vehicular and pedestrian alternate routes (see images below). Messaging to students and employees (<u>New Main Campus Entrance Link</u>)
 - The RH area will be closed from Mar 2024 to Feb 2026.
 - Lot 9 is open for students.
 - Lot 11 for staff only will be ready March 1.



- <u>Temporary Village (TV)</u> all reconfiguration scheduled to start April 2024.
- <u>CEC Redevelopment</u> Hiring of architects moving forward. Focus will be program refinement and schematic design with a selection panel and user group will be formed.

Maintenance Update

- <u>CEC Maintenance</u> improvements moving along. carpet, sealing, painting refresh. lighting improvements and maybe HVAC improvements. Awaiting roofing repairs assessment from consultant.
- Bldg. E Planning phase. Pool equipment and resurfacing.
- **Bidgs. G,H,W** HVAC replacement to start March to will last to the end of 2024. Replacing with high efficiency equipment. Temporary cooling to be installed during the project.
- Bldgs. L,T,X roof replacement this year.
- MCHS phase 1 roof repairs completed. Phase 2 is roof replacement.
- District wide key replacement project in pre-construction phase.
- **JSC:** Waiting on materials for accessible doors.
