How to Apply and Register

NOTE:

Online Records will have a new look beginning Summer 2009.

Students will have a new student ID number as well as a new login and password for **Online Records**.

Please check that your email address is current in your student profile online in order to receive your new ID and password.

Summer hours are Monday–Thursday, 8:00 am–6:45 pm

STEP ONE:

To apply to Santa Ana College, complete an application online at www.sac.edu. Click on the **APPLY NOW** link. After submitting all of your information, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from CCCApply. Within 24 hours, you will receive another e-mail from Santa Ana College with your student ID number and important registration information. You will be able to log onto Online Records to view your registration date within two business days of your application.

STEP TWO:

ONLINE REGISTRATION STEPS:

Online Records is open Monday–Sunday (Please note: The online system will not be available on Saturdays from 2:00 am to 5:00 am).

- 1 Go to www.sac.edu and click on the “Online Records” link.
- 2 Click on “Students” from the Main Menu.
- 3 From the Student Menu, click on the “Log In” tab at the top.
- 4 Log in (if you forget your password, go back to the Main Menu and click on the “What’s my password?” link).
- 5 Click on “Register for Sections” from the Registration Menu.
- 6 Follow the instructions to complete your registration.
- 7 Pay immediately to keep your classes.

DROP FOR NON-PAYMENT POLICY: NEW POLICY

Enrollment fees must be paid IN FULL within three business days of registration or all of your classes will be dropped and released to other students. If you need assistance paying your enrollment fees and would like to apply for a Fee Waiver, go to www.cccapply.org/BOG Waiver/. It is your responsibility to check your account balance and pay the amount owed.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY TO DROP CLASSES

To avoid a “W” grade, students must drop classes on or before the day of first class meeting. Students will not be automatically dropped for non-attendance. You may drop online. After the first day of the first class meeting you will not be eligible to receive a refund for your classes nor be exempt from payment.

WAIT LIST POLICY

You are not able to wait list more than one section per course. You cannot Wait List a course that will conflict with another course. As seats become available, students will be moved into an open seat. You will be notified by email (it is your responsibility to make sure that your e-mail is up-to-date) **and will have 3 business days to pay for the course or you will be dropped**. If your name remains on the Wait List, you must attend the first class meeting and obtain the instructor’s signature to add the course (Log in to Online Records often to check your status on the waitlist). Submit your Add Card to the Admissions Office and pay immediately.

Instructor signature is required for all petitioned adds.

PAY FEES IMMEDIATELY

Fees must be paid within 3 business days of registering for courses or you will be dropped for non-payment. The date that you register counts as the first business day.

Do not send cash! Make checks payable to “RSCCD” and write your Student ID number on the check.

Enrollment Fee: \$20.00 per unit, with no maximum. Payment is required of all students upon registering for classes.

Non Resident Tuition: \$181.00 per unit in addition to the per enrollment fee for out of state residents and \$191.00 per unit in addition to the per enrollment fee for students who are a citizen of a foreign country. Refer residency questions to the Admissions office.
Effective Fall 2009 non-resident tuition will increase to \$190.00 per unit addition to the per enrollment fee for out of state residents and \$205.00 per unit addition to the per enrollment fee for students who are a citizen of a foreign country.

Refunds: Students will be eligible for a refund if they drop their course on or before the day of the first class meeting.

Health Fee: \$8.50 for Summer session. This fee is mandatory for SCC and SAC campus classes.

Material Fee: Material fee may be required for a course. Check classes online for specific fees.

Student Service Fee: \$3.00 is payable for classes at SCC and SAC campuses. The fee includes: 1) \$1.50 for College Services: library, student and instructional services; and 2) \$1.50 for college activities. Photo ID and session validation is available at the Cashier’s Office, S-104 at SAC and E -102 at SCC. Payment of this fee is optional.

Parking Fee: \$8.00. A permit is required to park on campus and may be purchased at registration. Motorcycles are exempt in designated parking areas.

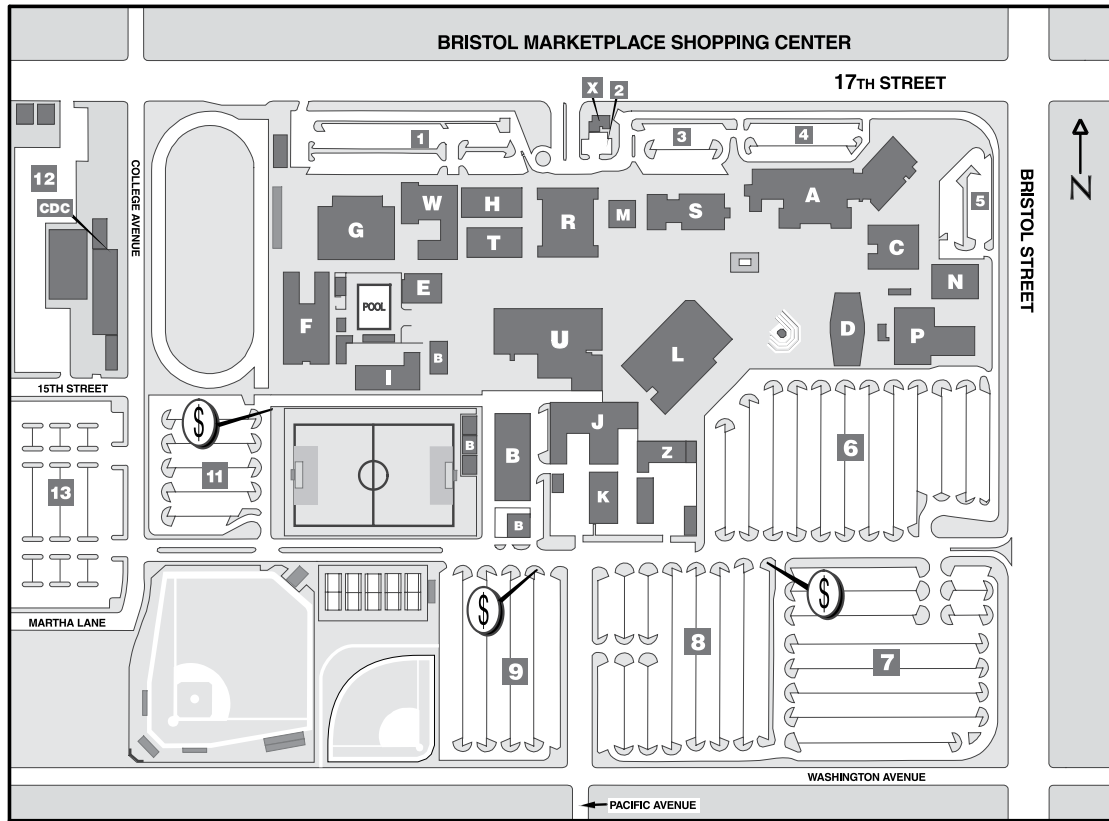
