Bonnie informed the committee that SCC is considering removing *VI: Computer Skills and Applications Requirement* from the AA degree (p. 32, 2008-2009 Catalog). Since both colleges are committed to maintaining the same degree requirements for the AA degree, SCC has requested the SAC C&I council consider this issue. If SAC decides to keep this requirement as part of the AA plan, SCC will adapt it to their curriculum. The TLC is in process of reviewing the *Core Competency 3: Information Competency* to include technology. This may eliminate the necessity for the catalog requirement. Bonnie recommended that this topic be taken to the division curriculum committees for preliminary discussion at the division level. This item will be brought back to the council for further discussion after the TLC, in consultation with SACTAC, presents the revised Core Competency.
