ARTICULATION OFFICER REPORT INFORMATION

1. Paula provided to the C&I Council members the C-ID degree review list that contained all the finalized TMC templates for AA-T/AS-T degrees. Paula informed the C&I Council members that if the courses within our approved degrees are not C-ID approved by Fall of 2014, then the degree will be deactivated.
2. Paula encouraged faculty to sign up for the C-ID listserv to stay informed regarding their areas.
3. Monica thanked faculty for all their hard work to reach the AA-T/AS-T degree goal that was set last fall. However, she also reminded faculty that our work continues as new TMC's are being approved.

UPDATE: CURRICULUM INSTITUTE 2013

INFORMATION

Monica did a presentation to the C&I Council on three topics from the Curriculum Institute 2013.

1. Creating Compliant and Effective Course Outlines – Our COR recently does not have Course Objectives which is mandated in Title 5; therefore, Monica requested that the C&I Council members discuss this item with their faculty during their Division Curriculum meeting. Anh-Phuong is working with Governet to put this field in the CurricuNET system. Monica will send out information to assist faculty in distinguishing between Course Objectives and SLO's. Information will also be sent out regarding Program Objectives. Discussion also took place regarding placement of SLO's on the public H-Drive.
2. Major Preparation- Whereas, in the past, focus has been on completing GE certification prior to transfer, some schools are now looking to see if students have completed major preparation coursework as well.
3. Implementation of Prerequisites – New changes at the state are making it possible for colleges to have a choice in how the establishment of communication and computation prerequisites are validated. Colleges can either choose from the traditional method of content review in combination with statistical validation or, now content review alone as accompanied by additional requirements (additional criteria that will need to be met as described in a plan that is developed by the individual college).  
Monica provided the C&I Council members the Title 5 regulations- Policies for Prerequisites, Corequisites and Advisories on Recommended Preparation (Title 5 – Section 55003) and also provided links for two papers from the ASCCC to become informed of the college's options. Further discussion and a vote will take place at the C&I council whether or not to pursue this new method of validation for prerequisites and to move forward on developing an implementation plan in conjunction with SCC.
