I. Public Comments

D. Khalid mentioned that none of the five (5) faculty requests for noncredit were ranked within the top ten (10) in the faculty hiring process. She expressed that noncredit faculty feel that noncredit faculty is not represented fairly compared to credit faculty. She shared facts on enrollment, revenue noncredit courses generate and their contributions to the institution as a whole.

H. Kim echoed D. Khalid's comments and broke down enrollment facts. He also mentioned that many noncredit students eventually transfer to credit.

R. Valles stated that CHST 150, ETHN 150 and ETHN 150H had a first read in Spring 2021; thus, courses should be listed as second read rather than first at the November 29th CIC Meeting. He explained that the only change from when the courses were first presented at last Fall's Meeting encompass a number change only.

- L. Pedroza shared his disappointment that noncredit faculty were not ranked within the top ten (10). He also expressed his support for noncredit faculty.
- C. Emley asked for clarification as to whether this is the right venue to bring up faculty hiring process and ranking concerns. She also voiced her support for noncredit faculty.
- C. Coyne stated that the faculty ranking issue needs to be brought up to the Academic Senate.
