Meeting was called to order by C. Coyne, CIC Chair, at 2:03 p.m.

I. Public Comments

C. Takahashi stated that he met with J. Lamb to explain the structure of the Engineering Department. He went on to read a statement that clarified his position on the proposed reorganization. Statement as read will be included in the minutes as an attachment.

K. Patterson stated that faculty are the best advocates of honor students. She encouraged faculty to send any student interested in being part of the honors program her way. She further mentioned that it is especially important for students who want to attend UCLA to join the Honors Transfer Program because the admitting GPA for UCLA is getting higher, and students not in honors programs have been admitted at a 26-28% rate whereas students who complete their honors program were admitted at a 76-82% rate over the past five years.

C. Kushida read a statement on behalf of the Distance Education Advisory Group. Statement as read: The Distance Education Advisory Group is concerned about the reorganization of Educational Multimedia Services (EMS) from Academic Affairs to the Public Affairs. EMS provides direct support services for Santa Ana College faculty and staff in the development of media projects. Their job includes essential hands-on support of faculty in the training and support of software and hardware for video creation. EMS' role is key to effective video creation from which our students directly benefit. The Distance Education Advisory Group strongly believes that EMS should remain in Academic Affairs, with continued support of Public Affairs and other campus areas.

IV. Guided Pathways (GP) and Student Equity and Achievement (SEA) Presentation –

S. Clark presented the New Faculty Institute Four (4) year framework, themes, and experiences plan. She described the Guided Pathways and Equity Framework Transforming a Culture which encompasses closing equity gaps and dismantling systemic racism. She spoke about state and local goals to develop a community of first-generation equity-minded practitioners. Guiding principles, foundational knowledge, professional practice, service and leadership training, service and leadership training, leaders, and facilitation as well as Professional Development were explained.

Discussion followed.

V. Academic Affairs Reorganization Presentation

J. Lamb described the current Academic Affairs organizational structure. He continued his presentation by walking the committee through the four (4) proposed phases of the reorganization to arrive at the final department/program shift. He acknowledged a meeting with C. Takahashi and faculty in the Computer Science Department to hear their concerns about moving to a different division. He also addressed the proposed move of Educational Multimedia Services (EMS) from Academic Affairs to the Public Affairs and assured faculty that no impact would be felt by faculty with this proposed move.
