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Cal-GETC proposal has now been reviewed by all three academic senates – CCC, CSU, UC Following system vetting outcomes and then consideration by the academic senates of all three systems, **ICAS will make a final decision in spring 2023.**

CalGETC proposal:

1) eliminates Area E (CSU-GE Lifelong Learning and Self Development); 2) \*eliminates language other than English (LOTE) GE requirement for transfer students but LOTE remains a graduation requirement for UC transfers, as it is for all first year UC admits; 3) Changes Arts and Humanities from a three course requirement to a two course requirement

CCC Resolution 15.01 directed the ASCCC to urge CSU include Lifelong Learning and Self-Development (LLSD) as a graduation requirement instead of an upper division general education requirement. The ASCCC leadership continues to advocate for LLSD opportunities for CCC students.

It appears that courses included on Cal-GETC (**this is NOT yet decided – just a best guess** in January 2023):

1. Will likely need to be UC transferable (not true of current CSU-GE)
2. Will likely need to be completed with a grade of C or better (not true of all areas of current CSU-GE)
3. In the Critical Thinking area will likely be writing intensive with instruction in writing, these courses will likely need to have ENGL 101/101H as a prerequisite (neither are true of current CSU-GE)
4. In the Oral Communication area will likely focus on content and not skill development, these courses will need to have ENGL 101/101H as a prerequisite (neither are true of current CSU-GE)
5. It also appears Cal-GETC will likely need to be completed in full or with a maximum of two courses completed after transfer (not true of current CSU-GE)
6. *Other questions:* \*will CLEP be allowed (as it is for CSU-GE)? \*will all CSU-GE Math courses such as Math for Future Teachers and Personal Finance be included? \*will first semester language other than English courses be included in Humanities as they are for CSU-GE? \*many others pertaining to catalog rights, grandfathering in existing GE approvals etc.

Courses approved currently for CSU-GE and not IGETC **may** benefit by being IGETC approved (*if possible*) when Cal-GETC is implemented. The below document provides information about course content etc. required for each IGETC GE area.
