



### Common Attributes of Two Year Graduates

(Graduation year 2016 – 2017)

The Research office has been looking at 2017 graduates who completed their degree in two years to examine commonalities that may have led to their success. The following list of characteristics were common amongst Psychology (6) and Liberal Arts: Art, Humanities, and Communication graduates (36) which made up approximately two thirds of students graduating in two years.

Attributes and program participation of all 67 two year graduates from AY 2016-2017:

- 93% were 19 and under in their first term
- 91% have an educational goal of earning a four year degree
- 88% were direct matriculants
- 85% were US citizens
- 72% participated in Orientation
- 69% were female
- 67% received Bog Waivers
- 58% participated in College Preparation
- 46% matriculated from SAUSD
- 45% received Pell Grants
- 40% participated in Adalante
- 0% had any veteran status
- 0% participated in MESA
