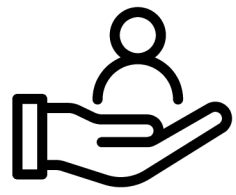


# STUDENT CIVIL RIGHTS @ SANTA ANA COLLEGE

You will not be judged or mistreated for who **you support, stand with, or are connected to**.

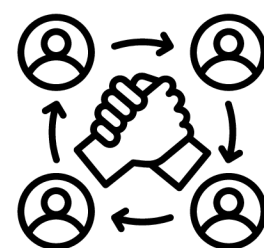
## YOUR RIGHTS



You have the right to **file a complaint** of discrimination, harassment, or retaliation.



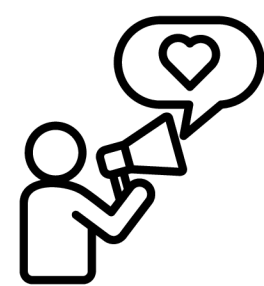
You have a right to be **taken seriously** and for your concern to be taken care of promptly, whether filed formally or informally.



You have the right to support services, such as **counseling, academic support, & protective measures** during and after reporting a concern.



You have the right to have your concern handled with sensitivity & **not to be punished** for reporting or participating in an investigation.



You have the right to speak up for **barriers, inequities, or treatment** that impacts your learning or safety.
