What: Campus Wide Fire Alarm System Test

When: November 3, 2017

Where: Santa Ana College – All Buildings

Work Hours: 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Activities:

The new Campus Wide Fire Alarm System will be tested on Friday, November 3, 2017 from 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Each building on campus will be transitioned from the old fiber optic cabling to the new fiber optic cabling. Once the connection to the new fiber is complete, (1-2) fire alarm devices in each building will be tested to ensure that it is functioning correctly and reporting to the main panel in the Security Building.

The campus will hear alarms and see strobe lights from the fire alarm devices throughout the day (1-2 devices per building) during this time. Each alarm/strobe will take approximately 45-120 seconds to verify, reset and silence. Please note that these alarms/strobes are part of a test and no action or emergency protocols need to be done on your end.

The entire campus will be placed on fire watch for the duration of the Fire Alarm System Test and occupants will be notified immediately in the event of a real emergency.
