2. Enter your Webadvisor login at the prompt:



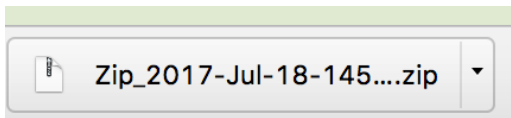
- Next to each of your Relay recordings is the option to DOWNLOAD. Click it and the video will download to your DOWNLOAD FOLDER AS A ZIPPED file. You will be asked: "Are you sure you want to download it". Click OK.

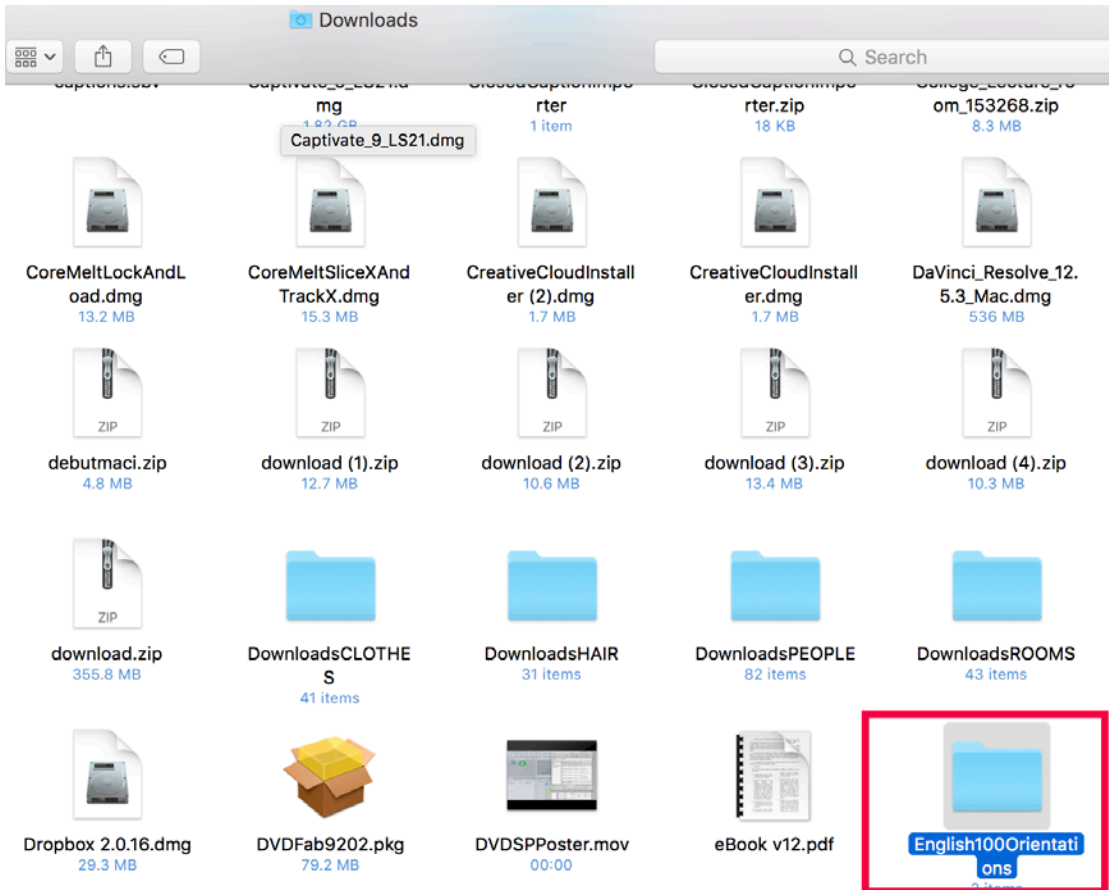

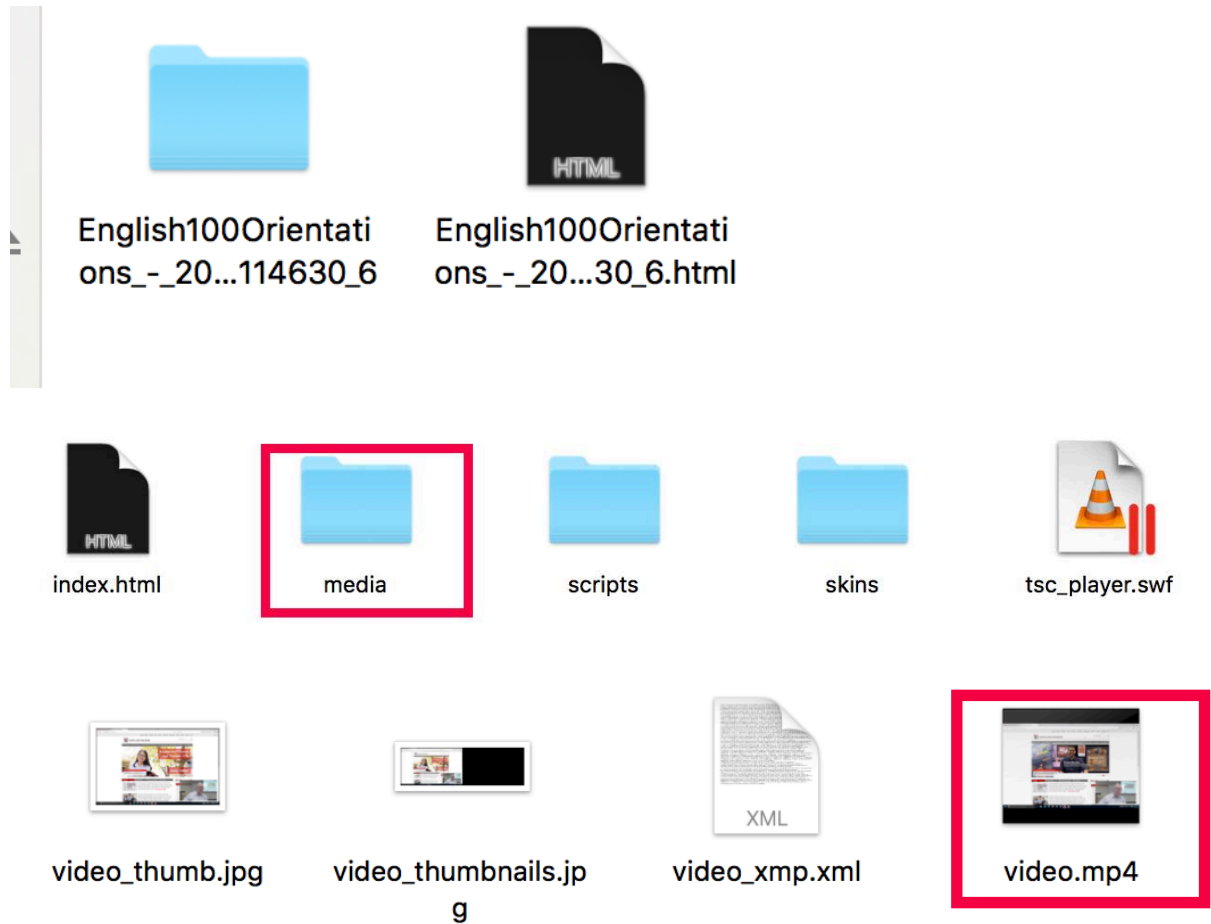
In this example, using Google Chrome, the lower left corner shows the downloaded zipped file. Double click it to unzip it and then search for this unzipped folder in your DOWNLOADS FOLDER.



In this example of my cluttered DOWNLOADS FOLDER is located the unzipped downloaded folder of the Relay recording.



4. Open this folder of the Relay recording and other subfolders until you locate the MEDIA FOLDER. Inside this folder will appear the MP4 VIDEO FILE which is your recording.



5. At this point, you have downloaded and located your video file. You are now ready to upload it to your YouTube Channel. If you have not created a YouTube Channel see my PDF handout available on my web site: <http://www.sac.edu/ems> on how to create a channel. Once you have a channel, sign in to YouTube, and upload your MP4 Video File within your channel page.

CAVEAT: YOUR MP4 VIDEO FILE WILL NOT CONTAIN THE CAPTIONS YOU GENERATED IN THE RELAY RECORDING PROCESS, SO YOU WILL HAVE TO USE YOUTUBE TO CREATE NEW CAPTIONS. If during the Relay recording process, you select the YOUTUBE profile, then the video and captions would transfer over to your YouTube channel automatically.
