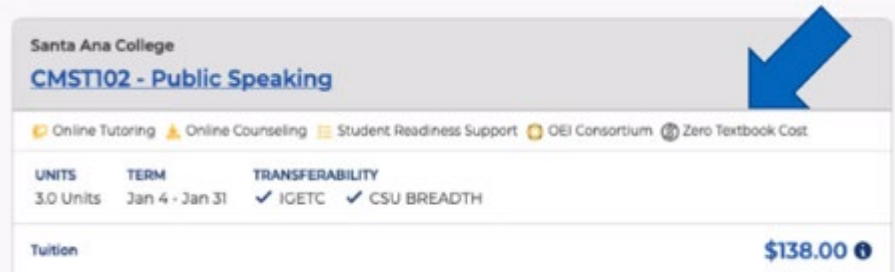


# Distance Education Advisory Group Meeting Agenda/Summary

March 9, 2022

- DE Strategic Plan
  - Discussed, reviewed/accepted updates.
  - Will forward final plan to Academic Senate.
- Canvas messages to entire class
  - Discussed faculty requests to eliminate the Canvas ability for students to message all students in the class without the instructor.
  - Agreed that DE should follow up with Canvas and test the student messaging environment without the instructor. Instructor messaging to the entire class should not be affected.
  - Will look into an addition to student handbook to include electronic communication.
  - A Shout Out will be sent on voting up an “idea” to allow students to block other students and to prevent students from sending message to all students at a class level.
- PIO marketing, ease of student distribution suggestions
  - Agreed that an image with alt-text provided is ideal for faculty to post

  - Discussed the importance of clarity for DE course types for students.
  - Will send out a draft prior to the next meeting for review.
  - Plan to finalize at the next meeting for Survey distribution in week 11.
