- 3. **Math and English Placement** - If you have not taken a college level math course or the SAC Math Placement Test, you are required to take a Math Placement Test.

 - **Schedule a time to take the English and Math Placement tests with the [SAC Testing Center](#)**

- 5. If you are an attending SAC student, meet with an **Online Degree Pathway counselor** for an Education Plan for the Online Pathway.
