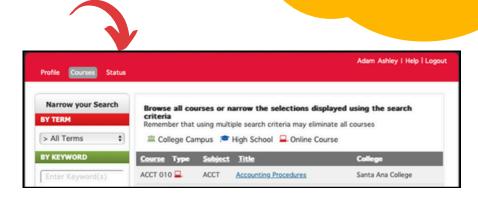


Dropping Courses on: sac.dualenroll.com

Log into sac.dualenroll.com with your SAC student email and password (sent to you from Santa Ana College after you applied - same as your Canvas Login)

You will land on a Course Selection Page.



Go to the Status tab to view your registered courses. Select "View Current Status" to view your courses.

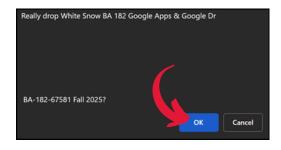
Review the course to drop and under Steps, select **Drop**.

NOTE: During the "W" grade period, it will show as **Withdraw**.



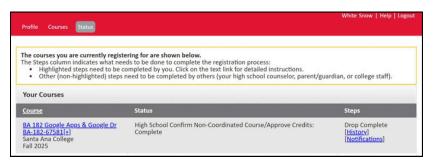
Another pop-up will show to confirm the course you are dropping.

Double-check you are dropping from the correct course.



Click "OK" to drop the course.

You get redirected to your Status page that will show processing status. When you are dropped, it will show "Drop Complete"



Important Info to Remember!

Deadlines to drop may differ between sections. Make sure
you always check the section add
and drop deadlines for each class.

NOTE: A "W" grade will not affect your GPA, but it will count as an attempt for that specific course title.

To find the section deadlines for your class go to <u>Self-Service</u> and click on the course title to get to "Section Details" - you will find the dates to:

- Add course with Add Authorization
- Drop without "W" no grade and not listed on SAC transcript
- Drop with "W" grade on SAC transcript





Additional Tips & How-To's:

Terminate A Pending Registration

Log in an go to "Status" - click on "View current status"

Find the class registration you want to terminate (only possible for registrations that have not yet been completed. Once a registration is completed you can only drop or withdraw from class, if the class within

drop/withdrawal deadlines).



Click on "Abandon" - enter a reason why you want to abandon the registration request, e.g. "Class no longer needed" and confirm.



Keyword VS Section Number Search

There are two ways to search for classes.

Keyword Search: If you want to look for a class related to a subject of your choice, **By Keyword** search will look for and **list ALL classes** under that subject. Keywords can be words, class name (HIST-120) or section numbers.

Section Number Search: If you want a specific class to enroll in, you can us search **By Section Number**: type your class in this format: *BUS-100-12345* (sample).

NOTE: You MUST include the dash lines (-), or it will give you all classes for the section name.

When you click the class title link, it will only show that specific class section.
