 Minutes from 3/3 and 3/12 were approved.
- III. Online Assessment Practices

A discussion on online assessment practices occurred. The discussion revolved around our current situation and the major shift in teaching.

Points raised:

- If faculty are currently not using Nuventive (TracDat) then they should continue to assess the way they have been.
- Assessment cannot happen until learning happens and vice versa.
- In terms of student assessment, we should focus on what to do between now and the end of the semester and then figure out next steps.
- Courses that require lab, etc. need to first focus on student's needs.
 Faculty need to put themselves in each student's shoes. SLO's will shift and expectation of that will also need to shift.

Questions that were raised:

- What will assessment require now that most classes have shifted to online? Will faculty have flexibility? Will faculty have the same deadlines?
- IV. Online Teaching Resource Development

There was a discussion on the lack of resources available to faculty trying to navigate courses online that are normally in-person courses. There was a consensus that more resources should be developed and provided to faculty. The committee will be working on providing resources for online teaching in the following weeks. One of these resources will include a database with best practices from other colleges.
