

CHANGE IN FORMAT: Beginning Spring 2016 the format of classes (i.e. – online and on-campus) will be the same for either the spring or fall start. In the new format both sections will have certain lecture classes online and certain lecture classes on-campus. Lab classes will remain on-campus as they have been.

In order to take online courses students will need to have a computer with access to the internet and a working email address. Students will need to have basic skills in internet access and word processing. Once enrolled in the class, there are two student tutorials on the Blackboard site to guide the student in use of the system.

Fall Class Enrollment Format - On campus lecture and lab classes will meet on campus twice a week from 3:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. during the first and second semesters. In the third semester on-campus classes will start at 3:00 pm one day a week and at noon one day a week. Students are also required to complete 32 hours of Level I fieldwork per semester. During the fourth (final) semester students are required to complete two eight-week full-time (40 hours a week) Level II fieldwork rotations. No courses are offered during the winter or summer semesters.

Spring (On-campus/Daytime) Class Enrollment Format - On campus lecture and lab classes will meet on campus twice a week from 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. during the first, second, and third semesters. In addition to this, students are also required to complete 32 hours of Level I fieldwork per semester. During the fourth (final) semester students are required to complete two eight-week full-time (40 hours a week) Level II fieldwork rotations. No courses are offered during the winter or summer semesters.

Please note: The semester you begin the OTA program will determine your permanent schedule for the length of your enrollment.
