

Certified Occupational Therapist Assistant (COTA)

An Occupational therapist is seeking an experience COTA to fill a position at a Certified Hand Therapy Clinic. Candidate must have experience with manual therapy and activities for patients who may have developmental, physical and emotional impairments. Individual prepares equipment for treatment and may perform clerical duties for the clinic.

- Requires an associate's degree and passing of a national examination to be a Certified Occupational Therapist Assistant (COTA)
- Familiar with standard concepts, practices, and procedures within a Hand rehabilitation clinic.
- Experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals, Must have excellent grasp of upper extremity anatomy.
- Splinting experience- A degree of creativity and latitude is required to create a custom fit Splinting.
- Operate in accordance with physician's orders and work under the supervision of an Occupational Therapist
- This Therapist will assess patients, and carry out therapy programs to restore maximum reasonable function and to minimize disability following disease, injury, or genetically acquired disabilities

Candidates will start part-time; position can grow into a full time position. Clinics hours are from 8-5, M-F. The majority of the caseload will consist of Hand related injuries. The setting is an outpatient professional facility.
