

LEARNING & MATH CENTER CHAMPIONS



PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The Santa Ana College Students 4 Students (S4S) Peer Mentor Program provides campus wide services aimed to increase the engagement, connectedness, and retention of students at SAC through the support of Peer Mentors.

The Learning Center and Math Center CHAMPIONS are peer mentors that will help raise awareness of the Learning and Math Centers through peer-to-peer advocacy. CHAMPIONS will increase student usage of the Learning Center and Math Center to help students be more successful and/or stay in their classes.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend mandatory S4S Mentor Orientation and End of the Year Celebration
- Maintain good standing (falling under 2.5 GPA will disqualify student)
- Must believe and have enthusiasm about the Learning Center and the Math Center missions.
- Make classroom and/or club presentations about the Centers, as needed
- Champions who complete all requirements of the program will receive a \$300 stipend at the end of the semester.
- AB540 and F1-Visa students: If accepted into the program, you'll need to obtain a Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) from the Social Security Administration.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Current active SAC student
- Full time student (Taking 12 or more units in Fall & Spring)
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Good oral communication skills and good knowledge of campus resources and campus life
- Must be on campus at least 4 days a week.
- Must be patient, willing and desire to work with SAC students from diverse ethnic, cultural, and socio-economic backgrounds
- Have utilized the Learning or Math Center in the past (preferably 12 hours or more)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Willing to answer questions about the Learning Center and the Math Center around campus.
- Invite students to utilize the services offered at the Learning Center and the Math Center
- Attend all 3 Champions training sessions scheduled during the 1st week of school, 5th and 15th week of school
- Wear Champions uniform full day on assigned days of each week for 15th weeks
 - Neon Green shirt: Learning Center
 - Neon blue: Math Center
- Check into the Center the day that you wear your uniform to have your timesheet signed
- Maintain the T-shirts so that they are clean and presentable each time you wear them
