Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Testing

Advance Placed/LVN-RN Students:

You are required to pass a diagnostic assessment test. Santa Ana College utilizes the **Test of Essential Academic Skills** (TEAS). It tests math, English, reading and science. All students are encouraged to log on to www.atitesting.com for study material and other useful resources and information.

A new version, ATI TEAS, is now available.

When you are on the entry list, you will be required to pass Version V (the previous version) or ATI TEAS if you have not already done so. When you pass the test, you must have ATI provide an official copy of your score (if not taken at Santa Ana College).

If you do not pass ATI TEAS on your first attempt, your name will be removed from the list awaiting your re-test.

- You must contact "The Learning Center" (learningcenter@sac.edu) for remediation, complete the remediation, and re-take the test. Generally, remediation takes six months to one year to complete. A student must show documented remediation after failing the test (anywhere) or wait at least one year before attempting the test again. If you do not pass the re-test, your name will be removed from the entry list.
- If you do not successfully re-test within 18 months after failing the test, your name will be permanently removed from the entry list and you will need to re-apply if you are interested and eligible to do so.
- If you have taken ATI TEAS as a second attempt (or more), you will need to wait at least 365 days before re-testing.
