Your Bridge to Santa Ana College

The Student Transition Program offers a bridge for continuing education students from non-credit to credit. The students who transition from non-credit to credit have various levels of academic preparedness and academic experiences. Many of the students are enrolled in English as a Second Language, Adult Basic Education, Adult High School Diploma, GED and or Career Technical Education program.

In the fall and spring semester a counseling component enhanced student success for non-credit students transitioning to credit. The additional services included transition success plans, counseling regarding academic and non-academic factors which may affect progress and/or transition, and various academic enrichment workshops to acquaint students with college processes and academic success.

989 student individual appointments were conducted where students received transition services.

148 Non-Credit students transitioned to SAC.

During the fall semester the ESL STP project was implemented to provide Intermediate ESL students with orientation, counseling and academic planning with the goal of college transition. A total of 2089 students in the School of Continuing Education received direct services by the STP program.
