## “Connect from home”

The Library subscribes to twenty-nine licensed full-text periodical databases, and nine reference databases (<http://www.sac.edu/students/library/nealley/articles.htm>), which provide access to over 20,000 full-text journals. These full-text databases support the college curriculum, are very popular, and are free to use by students, staff, and faculty.

The “Connect from home” page (<https://libnet1.sac.edu:2443/login>) provides 24/7 remote access to these full-text journals, magazines, newspapers, eBooks and reference sources.
