Giving Back During A Pandemic, SAC Alumni Fred Flores Finds Fulfillment in Unexpected Ways

As a SAC alum, Fred Flores is honored to come full circle with his alma mater and not only partner with the college to support the community through COVID-19 testing, but be in a position where he can make a meaningful contribution for students. His recent reconnection with his alma mater has led to him jumping in head-first with a \$20,000 donation to the Foundation's *Raising the Game* campaign.

Flores started his academic journey in the community college system, enrolling at Fullerton College and later attending SAC where he was able to transfer to UC Irvine. Flores later began working in Human Resources for the City of Orange, where his love for workforce development took full flight. After trying and failing to start his business three different times, Fred learned that if you fall down again and again, you have to get up each time in order to be successful. He opened North American Staffing Group, Inc. in 2000 and has never looked back.

As his business ventures grew, Flores' love for helping people grew as well. He reconnected with SAC

in 2020 when the COVID-19 pandemic hit and the demand to administer testing was in full swing. Fred and Medica Talent Group, Inc. worked with the college to provide COVID-19 testing for more than 36,000 community members. "There was a need to get more people tested for COVID-19, and SAC helped fill that need in the most accommodating way possible. I was also able to work directly with SAC Nursing students and see firsthand the talent and the need that these students have. The ability to partner with my alma mater meant so very much, and it only made sense to give back to a place that has given so much to so many people, including me," says Flores.

The partnership with SAC is one that Flores did not expect after all these years, but explained that the need to provide as many critical services and opportunities for students and the community during this pandemic was evident. As part of his passion to help others, Flores also helps support vaccination sites in Los Angeles and has created a strong workforce pipeline initiative that strengthen the alliances he is making with community colleges and educational institutions for students to gain employment in and after college during the pandemic.

"Having Fred Flores jump on board to not only partner with us to provide COVID-19 testing for the community, but also make a significant impact through a major gift to the SAC Foundation's *Raising the Game* campaign, means a great deal to all of us. His donation will help our students reach their academic and career goals, and the college as a whole. Fred truly embodies what we hope for our students. He is a successful, driven businessman who continually strives to do more for others and is always seeking ways to give back," said Dr. Marilyn Flores, Interim President at Santa Ana College.

As Flores reflects on his background and drive to help others, one thing always remains the same: his true passion to contribute to students' success by sharing his story and providing meaningful mentorship. "If people are willing to listen, I'm willing to share," Flores says. "I'm looking forward to strengthening my partnership with SAC and making it a tradition for years to come."




Interested in creating Facebook and Instagram banners for your department on social media? We would love to support you and help create more engaging posts for student, faculty and staff engagement!

Building Steam in STEM

STEM Exploration Month offered current and prospective students an opportunity to learn more about STEM disciplines and the Computers, Math and Science Pathway at SAC.

Over the month of April, seventeen workshops were held with over 250 participants! Workshops were led by 12 SAC STEM Faculty from Math, Geology/Earth Science, Chemistry, Computer Science, Physics and Biology. Pictured above is Dr. Kimo Morris from Biology sharing about his area of expertise, Applied Aquatic Sciences.

Three workshops were led by SAC STEM Alumni who are pursuing graduate degrees in Engineering Geology, Chemical Engineering and Biology. Two of the three Alumni were involved with MESA while at SAC.

MESA (Math, Engineering and Science Achievement) and Bridge to Engineering offered workshops providing SAC programs an opportunity to recruit STEM students.

Over 150 of the participants completed a workshop evaluation form where participants could comment on their experience at the event as well as provide STEM CAP Success Team some insights into student interest in the STEM Pathway.

- 78.5% of participants agreed that the workshop attended increased their interest in STEM
- 69% of participants were interested in learning more about the STEM Pathway at SAC

SAC Celebrates Top 30 Students & SAC Degree Earners

SAC Dual Enrollment began in the fall of 2015 with Santa Ana Unified School District (SAUSD). SAC began offering four SAC college courses and has now increased its course offerings to SAUSD and other unified school districts.

As the growth of this program continues, SAC in partnership with Century High School's Early College Program, celebrated the first 7 students who will earn their AA and/or Certificate of Completion.

On April 23, 2021, students were celebrated by parents, staff, and counselors for their success. In addition to the seven degree and certificate earners, Century High School also recognized its top 30 students, and among these students more than 90% of them were also dually enrolled students at SAC.

In recognition of their efforts, SAC awarded these students with a celebratory basket, which consisted of SAC gear. "The Early College program with SAC helped me become organized with my schoolwork and manage my time more effectively," said Elena Lopez, Early College program student. "As a result, I will have my A.A. degree from SAC and will continue my studies at UCSD, where I will be majoring in Public Health."

Furthermore, SAUSD Principal Nata Shin stated, "Century High School is pleased to partner with SAC in preparing our students with rigorous coursework and a jump start with their college careers. These are the first of many young alumni and we have the honor and privilege of being able to serve our community."

"CHS and SAC's Early College is leveling the playing field for our students of color by closing the post secondary enrollment and college completion gap, "said Mireya Vasquez, EC counselor.
