Dear Dr. Beno:

After the ACCJC Team Visit of October 20-23, 2008, Santa Ana College received the official Commission disposition letter dated February 3, 2009, placing the College on Warning with a Follow-Up Report due October 15, 2009. Four recommendations, one for the College and three for the District, were to be addressed in the Follow-Up Report.

On January 29, 2010, ACCJC notified Santa Ana College of the Commission's action taken on January 6-8, 2010 to accept the Follow-Up Report, remove Warning and reaffirm accreditation with a requirement that Santa Ana College complete a Follow-Up Report by October 15, 2010. On January 31, 2011, ACCJC notified Santa Ana College of the Commission's action taken on January 11-13, 2011 having reviewed and accepted the Follow-Up Report.

As part of the accreditation process, all colleges are required to file a Midterm Report in the third year after the comprehensive evaluation. Enclosed for your review and consideration are three copies of Santa Ana College Midterm Report, October 15, 2011, a disk with the Educational Master Plan 2007-2012 with updates 2010 and 2011, a disk of the Santa Ana college Follow-Up Report, October 2009 with Educational Master Plan Update 2009 and a USB Flash Drive containing the Santa Ana College Midterm Report, October 15, 2011 with documents electronically linked. For the Commission's reading convenience, all documents are linked from the PDF file to the appropriate document simply by keeping the PDF of the Midterm Report open and clicking on the document to be reviewed.

We appreciate the Commission's thorough review and consideration of the Santa Ana College Midterm Report and look forward to a positive response in January 2012.
