

## ~DAY BY DAY ITINERARY~

From the dramatic canyons of Zion National Park to the colorful spires and whimsical shapes that rise up from the Monument Valley floor to the steep, red sandstone walls of Lake Powell, on this new spectacular journey you'll discover the incredible sights and wealth of natural wonders amongst Arizona and Utah's colorful canyonlands. The hues of red, orange and brown amongst the spectacular cliffs and strange shapes that you will encounter will leave you in awe at Mother Nature's handiwork.



#### **DAY 1 ~ ARRIVE LAKE LAS VEGAS**

From our departure points this morning we travel by motorcoach to Las Vegas making several rest stops along the way. This afternoon we'll check into our beautiful and luxurious resort hotel in the desert oasis of Lake Las Vegas. Sculpted from colorful desert terrain of Southern Nevada, Lake Las Vegas is a private 320-acre lake that lies nestled within the desert mountainside just 17 miles from the Las Vegas Strip. This four-star Mediterranean-inspired resort hotel was formerly a Ritz Carlton and re-opened in 2011 after an extensive remodel. It features a breathtaking setting, unimaginable luxury, swimming pool, private lagoon with a private white sand beach, and the Casino MonteLago is located next door. This evening we'll embark on a Lake Mead dinner





**cruise** aboard a Mississippi-style paddlewheeler. The *Desert Princess* was designed specifically to cruise the glassy blue surface of Lake Mead. Enjoy an included dinner while we take in views of **Hoover Dam** and Mother Nature in all her raw beauty. (Dinner)

#### **◆DAY 2** ~ ZION NATIONAL PARK◆

Following an included breakfast at the hotel, we travel into Utah and through the spectacular Virgin River Gorge to Zion National Park. Zion is an ancient Hebrew word meaning a place of refuge or sanctuary. In sheer magnitude and color, Zion is very likely one of the most aweinspiring national parks in the world. Protected within the park's 229 square miles is a dramatic landscape of sculptured canyons and soaring cliffs. We'll enjoy an included lunch and then set out to see Lower Zion Canvon where we'll find massive canyon walls ascend towards a brilliant blue sky. Walk along the banks of the Virgin River as the sandstone cliffs that range in color from cream, to pink to red tower overhead. They could be described as sand castles crowning desert canyons. This evening we'll check into our hotel located just outside the park's entrance in Springdale. (Breakfast, Lunch)

#### •DAY 3 ~ ZION NAT'L PARK, LAKE POWELL•

Enjoy an included breakfast this morning before we depart and embark on one of the most aweinspiring drives in all of America as we make our way to Upper Zion Canyon via the historic Zion-Mt. Carmel Tunnel, a true engineering marvel. Within Zion's Upper Canyon we find the magnificent geologic wonder known as Checkerboard Mesa, the impressive hoodoos and twisted rock sculptures edged to the rim of the highway. Later this morning we'll arrive in Kanab known as "Little Hollywood" because of the many movies that have filmed scenes here including "The Lone Ranger" and "Planet of the Apes." In the Kanab area, we'll embark on a docent-guided tour of the Best Friends Animal Sanctuary the largest animal sanctuary in the country, at any given time it is home to 1,700 dogs, cats and other animals that have been brought here from shelters and rescue groups for special care. Many of them just need a few weeks of care before they're ready to go to good new homes with loving families. But there are also those who are the outcasts of society - unwanted, lame, too traumatized by past abuse, or too old, handicapped, or ill. For these lovable, innocent creatures, this sanctuary is a unique home and haven and there's just nothing else like it anywhere. Continuing east we'll soon arrive in Arizona and Lake Powell, where sparking blue water laps against towering red rock canyon walls and sandy beaches. The majestic beauty of this vast lake comes alive as we embark on a guided cruise and take in the sights of the "tapestry" walls of the Lake's Antelope Canyon and views of the gigantic Glen Canyon Dam. This evening we check-in to the lakeside Lake Powell Resort and enjoy lakeview rooms during a two-night stay. An included dinner tonight at the resort's elegant Rainbow Room. (Breakfast, Dinner)



### **DAY 4 ~ MONUMENT VALLEY**

Following an included breakfast we travel to Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park where wind and water has carved the famous sandstone spires and towers that rise hundreds of feet from the valley floor. We'll enjoy an included lunch and then board 4-wheel drive vehicles with a knowledgable Navajo guide onboard who will share with us their culture and showcase the colorful and oddly shaped red sandstone monoliths, buttes, and mesas – the setting for

so many movies, from John Ford films to *Forrest Gump*. We return to Lake Powell this evening with time to take a leisurely stroll along Wahweap Marina if you choose. (Breakfast, Lunch)



### **◆DAY 5** ~ LAKE POWELL TO MESQUITE**◆**

Following an included breakfast we'll visit the Carl Hayden Visitor Center to learn about Glen Canyon Dam. Completed in 1964 after eight years of construction, the dam tamed the waters of the Colorado River and created Lake Powell. At 186 miles long and a storage capacity of 27,000,000 acre-feet, it took 17 years for Lake Powell to fill. Exhibits at the visitor center showcase the concrete arch dam which contains 4,901,000 cubic yards of concrete and is 300 feet wide at the base. We depart and travel to Mesquite, Nevada. This evening we check into our resort casino hotel which offers tons of gaming action and outdoor pool - perfect for some relaxation and rejuvenation. (Breakfast, Dinner)

#### **•DAY 6 ~ JOURNEY HOME•**

Following an included breakfast we cross the expansive Mohave Desert and return to Southern California this evening with the colorful hues of Utah and Arizona's colorful canyon country forever ingrained in our minds. (Breakfast)
