Registration received by mail will be confirmed if you send a self-addressed stamped envelope. Registration received by phone and online will automatically receive a confirmation. If you do not receive a confirmation in 5 business days, call our office at (714) 480-7443. Non-receipt of confirmation does not warrant a refund.

REFUND & TRANSFER POLICY FOR ALL EVENTS:

Refund and transfer requests must be made (5) business days prior to the EVENT less a \$15 processing Fee per person. Day Tours: may be canceled up to 10 days prior to departure date less a \$15 processing Fee. A refund will only be issued if your space can be re-sold. You may send a substitute in place. 




