~DAY BY DAY ITINERARY~

This new single-hotel journey will showcase the new and the historic treasures in and around Las Vegas. We'll go from "neon to nature" as we go backstage on the "Strip", cruise on Lake Mead, ride the rails, descend into Hoover Dam, walk over the Grand Canyon, visit the newest museums and see the aerial acrobats of the Thunderbirds overhead. All the while, unpack and relax for four nights at a luxurious four-star resort in the desert oasis of Lake Las Vegas.



◆DAY 1 ~ ARRIVE LAKE LAS VEGAS◆

From our departure points this morning we travel by motorcoach to Las Vegas making several rest stops along the way. Later this afternoon we'll check into our beautiful and luxurious resort hotel in the desert oasis of Lake Las Vegas for a leisurely four-night stay. Sculpted from the colorful desert terrain of Southern Nevada, Lake Las Vegas is a private 320-acre lake that lies nestled within the desert mountainside just 17 miles from the Las Vegas Strip. This four-star Mediterraneaninspired resort hotel was formerly a Ritz Carlton and re-opened in 2011 after an extensive remodel. It features a breathtaking setting, unimaginable luxury, full-service spa, swimming pool, private lagoon with a private white sand beach, and the Casino MonteLago is located next door. Enjoy an included **welcome dinner** this evening. (Dinner)

• DAY 2 ~ NELLIS AIR SHOW, LAS VEGAS • Following an included breakfast at the resort we head to Nellis Air Force Base and honor our Veterans this Veteran's Day weekend at the Nellis Air Show. The event is not open to the

our Veterans this Veteran's Day weekend at the **Nellis Air Show**. The event is not open to the general public on Friday and the crowds will be minimal. The **Air Force** *Thunderbirds* are





scheduled to perform as well as other military and civilian aircraft. The event also celebrates the history of American aviation and salutes the recent accomplishments of America's military through approximately 100 military and civilian aircraft expected to be on display. This afternoon we visit the National Atomic Testing Museum, an affiliate of the Smithsonian that opened in 2005 to recognize the unique role that Nevada played in defending the United States during the Cold War. A **docent-guided tour** will showcase this repository for one of the most comprehensive collections of nuclear history in the world featuring a wide variety of materials and artifacts relating to the Cold War, the Nevada Test Site, Area 51, and nuclear and radiological science and technology. We return to Lake Las Vegas with the balance of the evening at leisure. (Breakfast)

◆DAY 3 ~ HOOVER DAM◆

An included breakfast this morning before we depart the resort and spend the day learning about the Hoover Dam and seeing it from a variety of vantage points. This National Historic Landmark stands today as a testament to the thousands of men and women who came to a harsh and barren land and in less than five years built a world renowned structure which changed the future of the west. Viewing this magnificent, massive man-made structure creates a respect for man's accomplishments. The strong desire to harness nature's power drove the human mind and body to build Hoover Dam in the hottest, driest area of the United States. First we head to Boulder City and board the Nevada Southern Railway for a 7-mile round-trip journey on a historic line that was built specifically to haul materials to build the Hoover Dam. You may ride in the recently refurbished Pullman Coaches dating back to 1911 or take in the views from the open car. Learn about the history of Boulder City, the city responsible for building the dam, and get close-up views of the Southwest desert. We'll then embark on a Lake Mead lunch cruise aboard a Mississippi-style paddlewheeler. The Desert Princess was designed specifically to cruise the glassy blue surface of Lake Mead. Enjoy an included lunch while we take in views of Hoover Dam and Mother Nature in all her raw beauty. Then, come face-to-face with the mighty Hoover Dam as we walk across the new Mike O'Callaghan - Pat Tillman Memorial Bridge (Hoover Dam bypass bridge). This bridge, completed in 2010, is the highest and longest arched concrete bridge in the Western Hemisphere and the second-highest bridge of any kind in the United States. Its setting is what sets it apart; it is perched 890 feet above the turquoise Colorado River; only 1,500 feet from the Hoover Dam. Walk to the center of the bridge and you'll walk right into Arizona! We then embark on a guided tour of the Hoover Dam. We'll see a brief video depicting the history of the Hoover Dam and then guides will escort you to an elevator for a 500-foot descent to get an up-close look at the power plant generators housed at the base of the dam. We return to the resort with the balance of the evening at leisure. (Breakfast, Lunch)

◆DAY 4 ~ DAY AT LEISURE OR SKYWALK◆

Following an included breakfast this morning you may enjoy the day at leisure or take advantage of an optional tour to the **Grand Canyon Skywalk** (*additional charge*). This all day adventure will take you to the west rim of the **Grand Canyon** and experience through the eyes of the Hualapai Indians the raw beauty of one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. You will travel off the main highways through 21 miles of one of the world's largest and oldest Joshua Tree Forests to the Hualapai Reservation (9 miles are by dirt road). The Skywalk

and oldest Joshua Tree Forests to the Hualapai Reservation (9 miles are by dirt road). The Skywalk is a glass-bottom "U"-shaped bridge that overhangs the Colorado River and the Grand Canyon. The 70-foot long, open-air Skywalk is suspended 4,000 feet above the canyon floor, providing 720-degree views on all sides. The cantilever design is a true engineering marvel and can support the weight of 71 fully loaded 747 airplanes (that's a whopping 71 million pounds), withstand winds up to 100 mph and survive a magnitude 8.0 earthquake! Don't miss your chance to walk over the Grand Canyon on the world's highest man-made structure – by more than 2,300 feet! Needless to say, this will be an exhilarating experience! (Breakfast)



DAY 5 ~ LAS VEGAS, JOURNEY HOME◆

This morning, following an included breakfast we head to the Mob Museum - Las Vegas' newest museum, it opened in 2012. Located inside the historic former federal courthouse in **Downtown** Las Vegas, this building is a mob artifact in itself. Inside you'll find exhibits that focus on both sides of the notorious battle between organized crime and law enforcement. The museum features high tech theatre presentations, iconic one-of-a-kind artifacts and interactive environments. It's as close as you can get to the Mob without being asked to wear a wire. Then, we head to the Las Vegas "strip" for a backstage tour of Jubilee! - to learn about the costumes, the system of backdrops and other secrets of Vegas' longest-running show. Our guide will be a showgirl as we see first-hand what it takes to bring this \$50 million stage spectacular to life. See how the massive sets are constructed, maintained and moved during performances. Visit the dressing rooms, costume construction and repair shops. Through the experience of a Jubilee! dancer, we'll see how it all comes together and learn a few secrets of the trade. Later this morning we begin our journey home making a lunch stop enroute. We return home with great memories of our unique and varied experiences on our journey from "neon to nature". (Breakfast)
