Activities:

Please be advised that the City of Santa Ana is continuing its work on the Bristol Street Widening Project which includes enhanced site perimeter improvements along the west side of Bristol Street adjacent the college. On Wednesday, January 24, 2018, the entrance to campus at Bristol Street and Campus Road will be closed intermittently throughout the day to accommodate demolition activities. There will be a flagman as needed during the demolition. The city's first phase of street widening work will focus on the east side of Bristol Street and the second phase of work will shift to the west side adjacent the college anticipated in April/May. Future construction alerts will be issued as city updates become available. The city street work is anticipated to last through Fall 2018.

The city's work includes widening of the street, underground utility work, enhanced drought tolerant landscaping, new lighting, improved sidewalks, new bike lanes and a center median within Bristol Street, including, accessibility upgrades at the entrance to Campus Road. The existing raised concrete island in the driveway will be demolished and replaced to meet new city engineering requirements at the entrance of Bristol Street and Campus Road.
