Activities:

The new Science Center building will be undergoing testing of the Fire Alarm System beginning on Friday, February 28th and continue on Saturday 29th, 2020. The hours of testing will occur from 7:00 A.M. through 3:00 P.M. During this time, audible alarms (horn sounds) will be heard beeping from the Science Center building as fire alarm devices are being tested by the contractor to meet required inspection tests.

In addition to the sporadic beeps and alarms, you may hear a recorded message stating "May I have your attention please, an emergency has been recorded in the building. Please leave the building by the nearest exit or exit stairwell, do not use the elevators". This is an audio evacuation test only for the new Science Center building.

These tests are required to ensure the fire alarm devices and announcements within the building are operable. This testing will not affect other buildings on campus or the existing campus fire alarm system.
