- I. Welcome / Introduction of Dr. Al Solano, Guided Pathways Consultant – Dr. Al Solano provided background on his work with integrated planning and guided pathways, an overview of the guided pathways framework, and his role in supporting our guided pathways implementation at Santa Ana College.
- II. Demonstration of Online Educational Plan – J. Campos & T. Pov demonstrated the online educational plan, focusing on its utility for students. Questions from the committee were raised concerning ease of use for students, existing data from student use, notification capability for students who are “off the path,” and its current status (available to students, but not promoted). The online education plan task force is working on a timeframe for rolling out full-scale use.
- III. Meta-Majors Workshop Update – K. Patterson provided an update on the meta-majors workshops on April 19 and April 20
- IV. IEPI Advanced Guided Pathways Workshop – Participants who attended the April 3 workshop provided their take-aways from the session which included, the importance of understanding that planning will take several iterations, the importance of including classified staff into GP design and implementation, best practices from community colleges that are further along in their GP work.
- V. Update on Technology Projects – J. Steffens provided an overview of technology projects that he is working on and how these relate to our GP work at Santa Ana College. Presented were the Project Process (needs assessment determines gap analysis which informs tool selection and implementation), the Governance Process (workgroup, SACTAC, Academic Senate/Planning & Budget, and TAG committees), and a Project List as they relate to the four pillars of the guided pathways model.
- VI. Design Team Reports – Design team co-leads provided brief reports on the progress of their respective teams. Upcoming meeting times for design teams were requested.
