Meeting was called to order at 1:00pm

- I. Welcome to new members (and guests) of the Guided Pathways Steering (GPS) Committee – new members and guests were given the opportunity to introduce themselves to the GPS committee.
- II. Update on Guided Pathways @ SAC – F. Ortiz updated the committee on meeting with department chairs where he is communicating Guided Pathways activities at Santa Ana College, providing information about the statewide initiative and introducing the program map template and examples. F. Ortiz has also been updating the Academic Senate and will begin to present at the Teaching and Learning Committee
- III. “Clarifying the Path Event” – Academic Cluster Design Team – A meta-majors sorting workshop will take place on two dates; April 19, 2:00 to 4:00 pm in D-109 and April 20, 8:30 to 11:00 am in the small gym. - V. IEPI Workshop on April 3 for Design Team Co-Leads and Members – approximately 12 SAC faculty, counselors, and classified staff will be attending the April 3 IEPI Guided Pathways workshop on April 3 at the Marina del Rey Marriot.
- VI. GP Website Content Suggestions – F. Ortiz requested from the committee suggestions for the additional content to be added to the Guided Pathways website at sac.edu. It was suggested that 1) committee documents be added to site, 2) links to the IEPI site be added along with instruction on joining the IEPI listserv, and 3) the addition of a student interaction link for students to learn more about guided pathways including videos of student testimonials.
- VII. Design Teams: Design teams were provided with instruction to brainstorm on practices currently used at SAC and to generate ideas on how to scale those practices, specifying which other stakeholders would be needed, and any resources needed. Design teams

were also provided direction on developing specific plans of action for the next 18 months.

After design team session, each design team reported on out on their work. Brainstorm and Plan of Action are due to F. Ortiz by April 13, 2018. Follow-up and design team reporting will take place at next Guided Pathways Steering Committee meeting.
