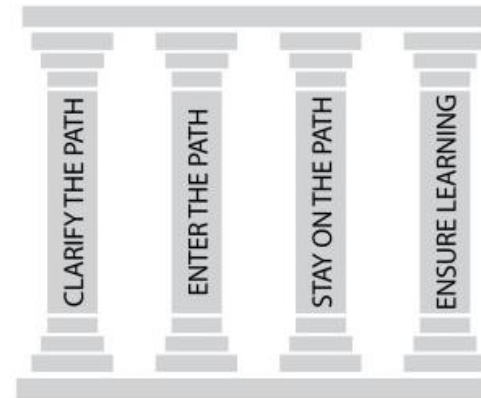
What are Guided Pathways?

- Ensure Learning



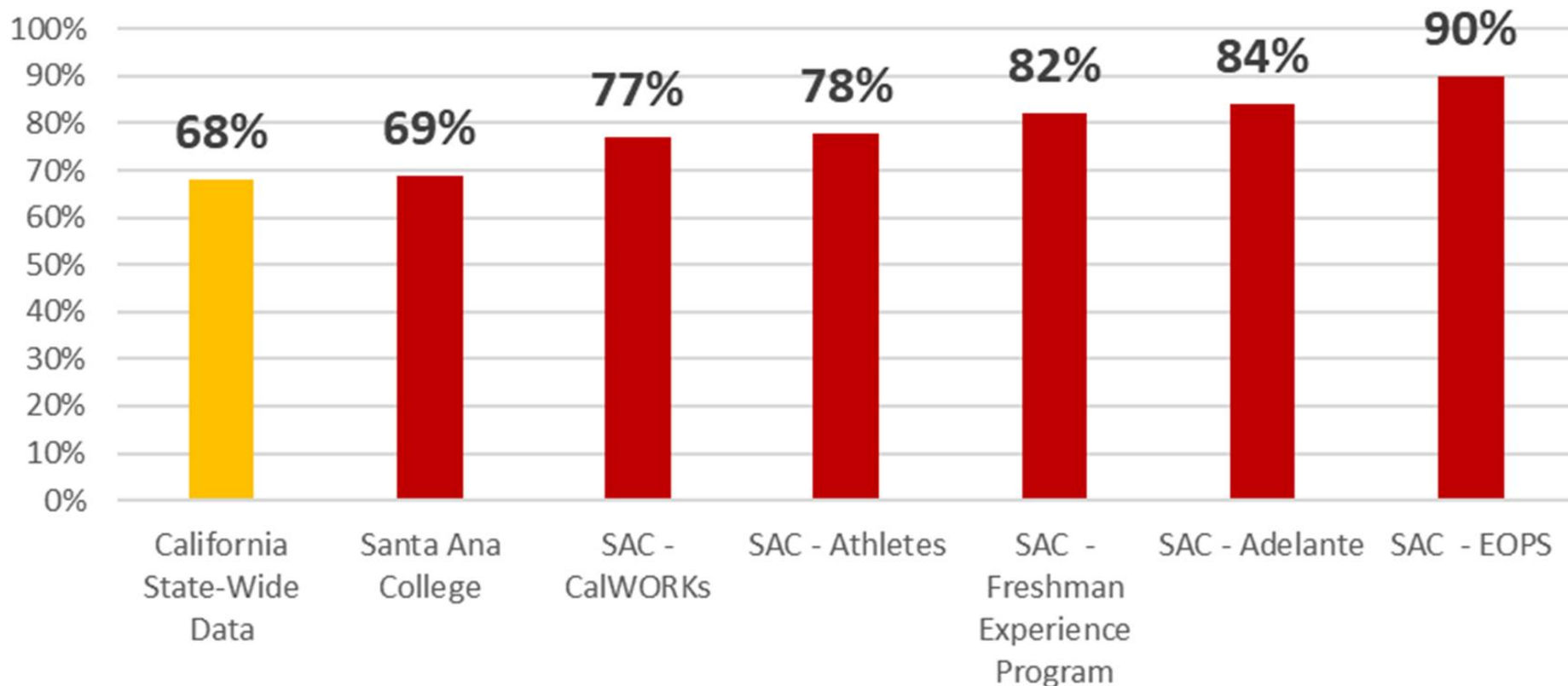
- Can dramatically increase student success
- **College-wide undertaking** that provides a framework for integrating existing initiatives and programs

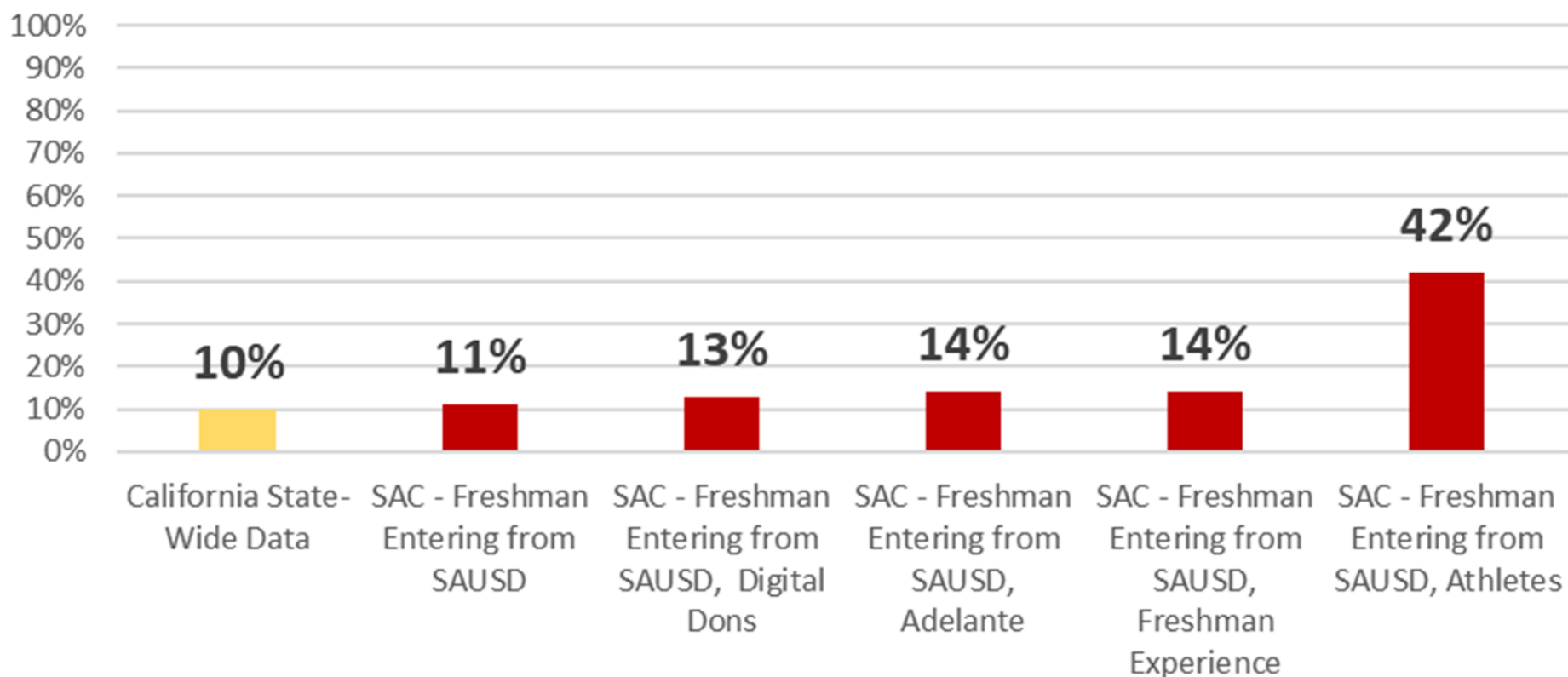
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Why do we need Guided Pathways?

Persisted from Fall to Spring	47%	68%
Successfully Completed Transfer Level Math and English in Year One	5%	7%
Successfully Earned 12+ College Credits in First Term	9%	13%
Successfully Earned 15+ College Credits in First Term	2%	3%

- **Core Team Work**

- Institute participation

- **Steering Committee**

- 30+ members
- Classified, faculty, and administrators
- Monthly meetings



What are the next steps?

- **Review Existing Programs**

- SAC offers approximately 280 programs
- Many have 0 or very few students enrolled
- Departments should identify low enrolled programs and consider removing

- **Develop Program Maps**

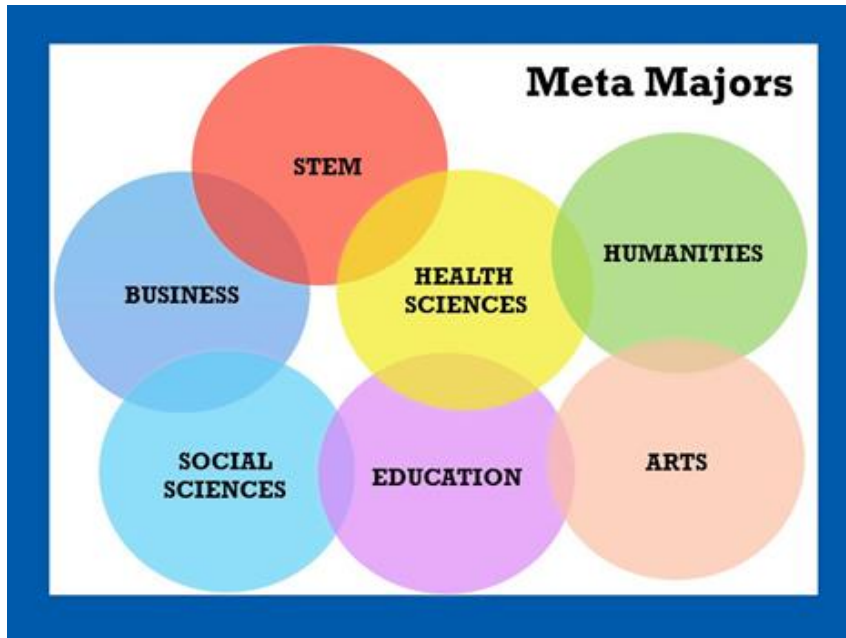
- Map all majors into a 2 or 3 year completion path
- Include recommended GE courses
- Flexibility in course selection

- **Develop Meta-Majors**

- Grouping our 100+ majors into smaller number of “meta-majors”
