

What are Guided Pathways?


- A redesign of our college programs that is student-centered
 Making our college ready for students!
- Based on four pillars:
 - Clarifying the Path
 - Entering the Path
 - Staying on the Path
 - Ensure Learning
- Can dramatically increase student success
- College-wide undertaking that provides a framework for integrating existing initiatives and programs

Persisted from Fall to Spring	47%	68%


*Persisted from Fall 2016 to Spring 2017






Why do we need Guided Pathways?

Successfully Earned 15+ College Credits in First Term	2%	3%




Attempted 15+ College Credits in 1st Term





Why do we need Guided Pathways?

Successfully Earned 30+ College Credits in Year One	3%	5%




What work has been done?

Core Team Work

- Institute participation

- Monthly meetings



What are the next steps?

Review Existing Programs

- SAC offers approximately 280 programs
- Many have 0 or very few students enrolled
- Departments should identify low enrolled programs and consider removing


Develop Program Maps

- Map all majors into a 2 or 3 year completion path
- Include recommended GE courses
- Flexibility in course selection

Develop Meta-Majors

 Grouping our 100+ majors into smaller number of "metamajors"
