- **International Travel:** Must demonstrate clear impact on students and/or local community
- **Application Window:** October 1-31, 2025 (For Conference attendance from January - December 2026)

- ☐ How well does this activity support college priorities and your job responsibilities?
- ☐ What will you accomplish and how will you share your learning?
- ☐ How will this help reduce barriers for students who face educational challenges?
- ☐ How will you spread knowledge gained to benefit others?
- ☐ Could this be scaled up if successful?

10-12 points	Recommend with Conditions	Approve with modifications or reduced funding
