The members of SAC's Reading Apprenticeship Learning Community of Practice (LCoP) made a presentation on our efforts to support the adoption of Reading Apprenticeship (RA) routines by credit and noncredit faculty. Outside of keynote speakers, the conference consisted of a number of workshops related to leading campus efforts to improve reading across the curriculum as well as how RA can be applied in different areas such as FYE programs and STEM classrooms. Personally, I was most impacted by two of the workshops: "Implementing Reading Apprenticeship into Mathematics Courses" and "Embrace the Formative: Moving Metacognition Online." Both workshops provided help with two areas I am interested in working on in the future - math reading skills and the use of RA routines in an online class.
