We attended the ACCCTEP Annual Convening on Friday, October 25, 2019 at the LAX Hyatt.
The Keynote featured Dr. Patrick Camangian's presentation on From Coping to Hoping: Teaching Students to Thrive Through Social Trauma. Some key points from his keynote presentation were:
- Create community connected education (increase student engagement, shift perspective of students, connect teaching to social emotional health & well-being (humanity to thrive)
- Use culturally relevant pedagogy & critical literacy
- Thrive = copying & hoping; teach to be a bigger person - making sense of pain
- Social Trauma - (1) submission, (2) survival, (3) recovery, (4) thriving
We also presented during the afternoon session of this convening; our presentation focused on "Integrating Teacher Pathways with Guided Pathways." In our 40 minute presentation, we specifically shared about Guided Pathways and our CDES Department at SAC. Then, we provided a 20 minute time frame for questions from other California Community Colleges to help support their Guided Pathways within their Teacher Education programs.
