# e. Planning & Budget - Ed Fosmire

- Updated info from State budget funding model- June 15<sup>th</sup> budget due- new split moving towards a 60% (FTEs)-20% (equity)-20% (student success) model. Built into it is more flexibility in ways to attain the student success number. Also, two-year hold harmless component instead of one, helping to sustain certain level of funding though 2019-2020.
- Some uncertainty if we can fully restore to 2015-2016, but hopeful. If so, it would mean 8% funding increase next year and 4% the following year, totaling 12% funding increase over the next 2 years.

#### f. Facilities - Brian Kehlenbach

- Johnson building will be demolished soon—vacated by the end of the semester.
- Science Center structural steel going up in 4-6 weeks.
- H building -window replacements this summer.

- The college is meeting with an architect to discuss uniform lettering on buildings as well as electronic directories at 6 campus locations. A scope of work is under development.
- Cesar Chavez building ongoing- Business Division relocated this summer.
- Magnetic door strip problems- contact Safety.
- District wide door lockdown system- recommended to BOT in June to hire consultants for input.
- Blue phones going out to bid this summer.
- Active shooter drill this summer.
- HEPSS taskforce committee assessment on student disruption incident in administration building this semester. Need to let people know when the threat is over & updates during a disruption.
- More homeless on campus.
- Irrigation issues checked weekly.
- A proposal was made by Fine & Performing Arts to establish an art space between the P, C and N buildings to include shaded canopies.
