Concerning "A" Building

Whereas, Rancho Santiago Community College will be replacing the "A" Building utilizing funds from a state building bond initiative;

Whereas, the Business Division and Fine and Performing Arts faculty and staff have made recommendations to house the division offices of Business and Fine and Performing Arts in the "A" Building so as to maximize available classroom space, to minimize duplication of equipment and space (copy machines, conference rooms, work areas);

Whereas, the Chancellor has decided she would like to relocate her offices and the Board Room to the "A" Building;

Whereas, the Chancellor has decided to relocate the Division Office for Fine and Performing Arts to the "C" Building at the expense of two classrooms and utilizing funds that would otherwise be available for instruction and personnel;

Whereas, the Chancellor's plan would utilize a large classroom on the first floor of the "A" Building as a combined Board Room and large classroom, requiring utilization of District personnel to "convert" the room from Board use to classroom use;

Whereas, the Chancellor's plan would remove two classrooms from the "C" Building and impair the use of the large classroom as a classroom in the "A" Building;

Whereas, the Chancellor has declared that Rancho Santiago Community College District is in a state of fiscal emergency and the Chancellor's plan would expend unnecessarily funds to relocate Fine and Performing Arts in the "C" Building and funds to move and relocate the Chancellor and the Board in the "A" Building that would otherwise be available for instruction, personnel and to furnish classrooms and faculty work areas.

Therefore, be it resolved as follows:

- a. That the Chancellor and the Board should remain in the Administration Building.
- b. The large classroom on the first floor of the "A" Building should remain as a classroom and not as a joint classroom/board room.
- c. The division offices of Business and Fine and Performing Arts should be located in the "A" Building as proposed by the faculty and staff of the Business and Fine and Performing Arts Divisions.
