Whereas, administrators and managers are hired and paid to administer and manage;

Whereas, professors are hired and paid to teach;

Whereas, the State of California mandated by law through AB1725, that professors and administrators share in the governance of the California Community Colleges;

Whereas, the Faculty Academic Senate Presidents and faculty representatives on the various District committees have continuously articulated concerns about limited/non-existent Shared Governance;

Whereas, the Faculty of Academic Senates have repeatedly sent forth resolutions and voice their concerns pertaining to limited/non-existent Share Governance at Rancho Santiago College, which have been ignored.

Be it resolved as follows: That the Rancho Santiago Community College District Faculty Academic Senate hereby gives notice to the Rancho Santiago Community College Board of Trustees and the Rancho Santiago Community College administration that effective this date the Academic Senate will no longer participate in the planning and budget process.
