

Join the Puente Program 2020-2021

What is the Puente Program? Puente links three components to help students prepare for transfer to 4-year colleges:

1. English: Students need to be eligible to enroll in 2 consecutive English classes, Engl. 101 (Fall 20) and Engl. 102 (Spring 21). These courses provide a supportive environment for students to develop their writing skills utilizing Chicano/Latino literature.

2. Counseling- Students work with the Puente Counselor to meet their goals. Students need to enroll in 2 counseling classes: CNSLG 100 (Fall 20), and CNSLG 106 (Sp. 21)

3. Mentoring: Students will be introduced to professional mentors who will share their academic and career experiences.

What are the benefits of the Puente Program?

- Build college friendships

- Guaranteed English classes
- Field trips to colleges and universities and scholarship information
- Priority to students seeking letters of recommendation

To participate, a student must:

- Commit to a full year of English and Counseling classes
- Participate in at least one out-of-class Puente activity per month
