CBEST: California Basic Educational Skills Test

The CBEST is designed to test basic reading, mathematics, and writing skills found to be important for the job of an educator; the test is not designed to measure the ability to teach those skills.

- 1. Reading Comprehension 50 multiple choice questions
- 2. Math 50 multiple choice questions
- 3. Writing 2 essays; personal experience and an issue
- 4. Passing score valid for life
- 5. Paper-based and Computerbased testing options

CSET

- 1. Based on current California Curriculum Standards K-12
- 2. Used to demonstrate subject area knowledge and competency
- 3. Currently passing scores valid for 5 years
