ABOUT THE EXAM

This is a standardized CollegeBoard Advanced Placement examination and is given nationwide only once a year in early May. Special provisions have been made with Santa Ana High School to allow Santa Ana College (SAC) students the chance to take the AP Spanish Exam in order to receive transferable college credit. Credit assigned varies by the university and score received. See your counselor or university representative for specific credit information.

ELIGIBILITY

- Current SAC student
- Attended Information Session
- Bring SAC ID to information session
- Have NOT taken Spanish 101 or 102
- Have NOT attended a high school where Spanish was the primary language of instruction.

FEES

It is the student's responsibility to meet strict payment deadlines. Failure to do so can jeopardize your ability to take the exam. Staff will determine if student qualifies for the reduced fee.

- Exam Fee: \$100
- Reduced Fee: \$70
