Guidelines for Requesting Reinstatement to EOPS/CARE for 2014-15

- Reinstatement is <u>not</u> guaranteed. Follow the instructions below for the category that fits your situation and submit your responses and all required documents <u>no later than the first day of the semester</u>.
- Reinstatement requests will be considered only as program space is available and on a first-come, first-served basis.
 Priority for reinstatement will be given to students who also qualify as CARE, YESS and veteran students.
- The quality, thoughtfulness, and completeness of your responses to the question prompts will be reviewed by a committee which includes the EOPS Associate Dean, an EOPS Counselor, and staff person. This is your chance to demonstrate that you have a well-developed plan for re-focusing your efforts on your academic progress.
- The review committee will make a decision only <u>after</u> the program's new/continuing student numbers for the semester are finalized and space available is known (typically around the 3rd week of the semester).
- Former SAC EOPS/CARE student with a break in continuous enrollment (Fall/Spring) in good academic standing:
 - Complete an EOPS application at the next open enrollment period.
- > Student who is applying for reinstatement after having been dropped in the previous semester (fall, spring) for non-compliance with the EOPS Mutual Responsibility Contract (MRC).
 - o Provide responses to the question prompts which begin below.
- Student who is applying for reinstatement after leaving EOPS while on probation.
 - o Student with break in continuous enrollment needs to complete EOPS application at the next open enrollment period.
 - o Provide responses to the question prompts which begin below.
- > Student who is applying for reinstatement <u>after termination from EOPS/CARE program and/or academic</u> disqualification.
 - Student with break in continuous enrollment needs to complete EOPS application at the next open enrollment period.
 - Submit a transcript showing successful completion of at least 12 units with a minimum 2.0 GPA in a semester that followed their termination from EOPS/CARE and/or expulsion from RSCCD (SAC or SCC).
 - o Provide responses to the question prompts which begin below.
